1. Downtown Bellevue Walking Tour – starting at Service First desk Tour led by Emil King, Strategic Planning Manager and Patti Wilma, Community Development Planning Manager – Planning & Community Development; Liz Stead, Urban Design Land Use Manager – Development Services

The April 22, 2015 Planning Commission meeting is a walking tour focused on an orientation to the Downtown Land Use Code and zoning framework. The tour will begin in the City Hall Plaza. Route and zoning maps are attached. Scheduled stops and nearby zoning include:

- Civic Center/ Metro Site/ BTC Station DNTN-01, 02, MU & OLB Explanation of the Downtown context and Downtown districts. Discussion of the development in the vicinity, building height and form, Pedestrian Corridor and the planned light rail system.
- Office Core DNTN-01 & 02
 Continued discussion of existing and planned development (the Downtown Core) including guidelines and standards that create Bellevue's urban form.
- 3. Ashwood DNTN-MU & R
 Discussion of the Perimeter Design District (PDD), transitions to
 adjacent neighborhoods and the Downtown's "wedding cake" form.
- Northwest Village DNTN-MU & R
 Continued discussion of the PDD, development potential in the area, and character of Downtown Districts.
- Pedestrian Corridor DNTN-01 & 02 & MU
 Discussion of the vision for the Corridor, relationship to the Council priorities and development in the area
- Old Bellevue DNTN-OB & MU
 Discussion of recent development activity, and neighborhood character.
