


Construction Alert

Safe Routes to School Project: New Sidewalk on 105th Avenue SE

June 2021



To improve pedestrian safety for students walking to and from Bellevue High School, a Safe Routes to School Project will:



Build a 6-foot wide sidewalk on the east side of 105th Avenue SE.



Build a raised crosswalk with curb extensions at SE Cliff Place.



Install parking areas where feasible on the east side of the street. The west side parking shoulder will remain. Zone 3 parking remains signed for residents and guests.

Install flashing school zone sign between 345 and 355 105th Ave SE.

IMPACTS

■ **Schedule**: July through Nov. Work is weather dependent; schedule may change.

- **Traffic control**: Northbound lane of 105th Ave SE will be closed. Two-way traffic will be maintained by traffic control flaggers.
- Work hours: Mon.-Fri., 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Weekend work may occur.
- **Safety**: Follow flagger's instructions, obey traffic signs and watch for people walking and biking.
