# West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE



### Multipurpose Path and Water Main Replacement Projects

New detour south of Northup Way begins mid-July

Thank you for your patience during construction of roadway safety upgrades and utility improvements along West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE (Parkway). The multipurpose path on the west side of the Parkway, north of Northup Way, is open for use. Construction of the water main north of SE 1st Street and paving between Northup Way and Lake Sammamish Lane NE are nearing completion so that two-way traffic on the Parkway can be restored. Water main construction continues south of SE 1st Street.

The second phase of construction begins at SE 1st Street and ends in the 1900 block of the Parkway. To complete this phase of work, a new detour route south of Northup Way is being implemented starting mid-July. The previous detour route has ended.

#### What to expect

- Southbound traffic on West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE will be detoured between Northup Way and SE 26th Street (blue line on map).
  - Vehicle traffic turning onto the Parkway between Northup Way and the 1900 block must travel northbound (green line on map).
  - Vehicle traffic turning onto the Parkway between the southeast 1900 block and SE 26th Street can travel northbound and southbound.
- Northbound traffic on the Parkway will not be detoured but may experience delays when traveling through the project work area.
- **Speed limit** within the work zone will be reduced to 25 mph at all times.
- Work hours are 7 a.m.-6 p.m., Monday-Friday.
- Pedestrian and bicycle access will be maintained on the west shoulder of the Parkway.
   People bicycling northbound may also use the northbound travel lane.

#### For your safety

Please follow flaggers' instructions and obey traffic control signs. Plan your travel in advance and follow detours.
