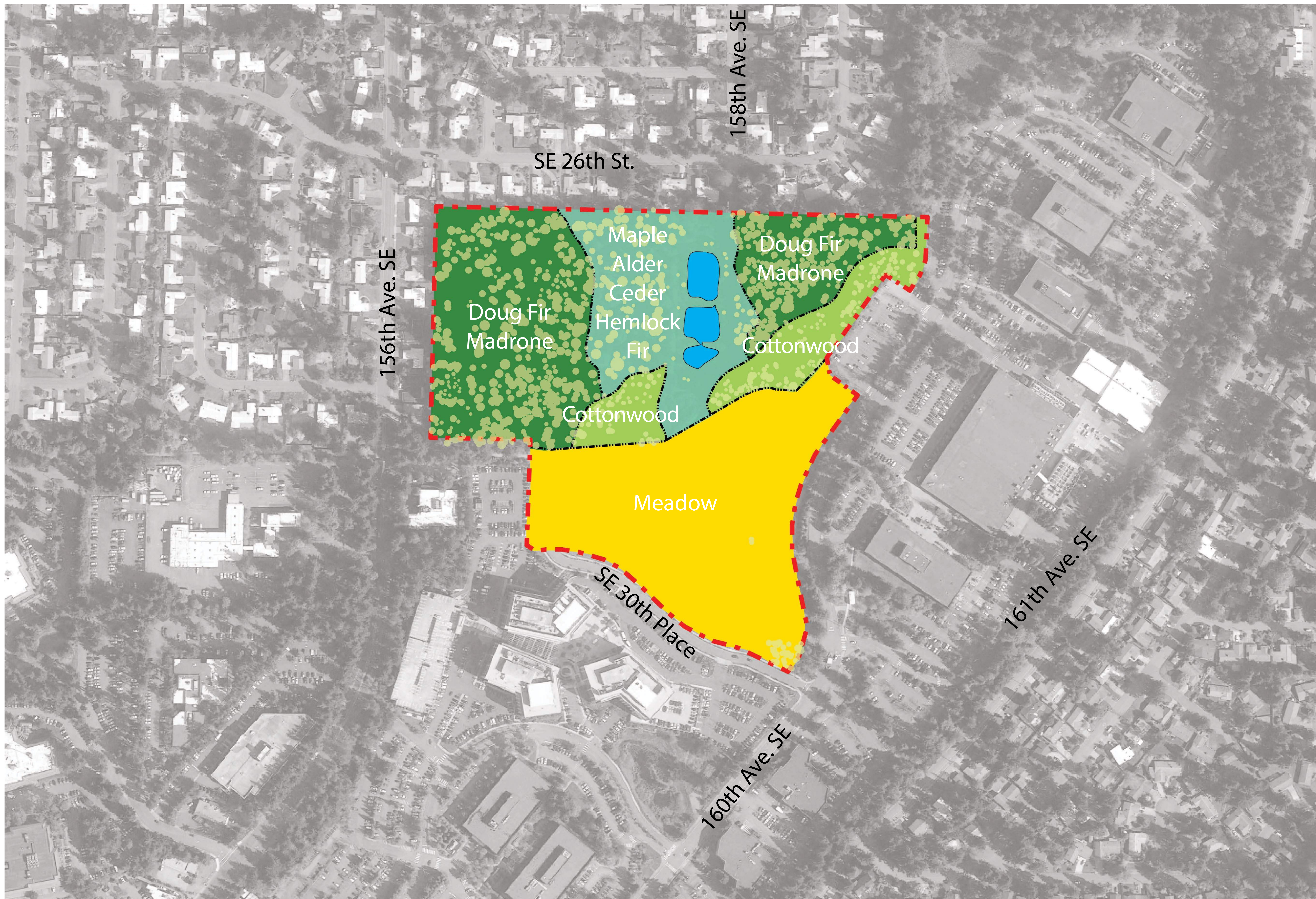


Surrounding Land Use

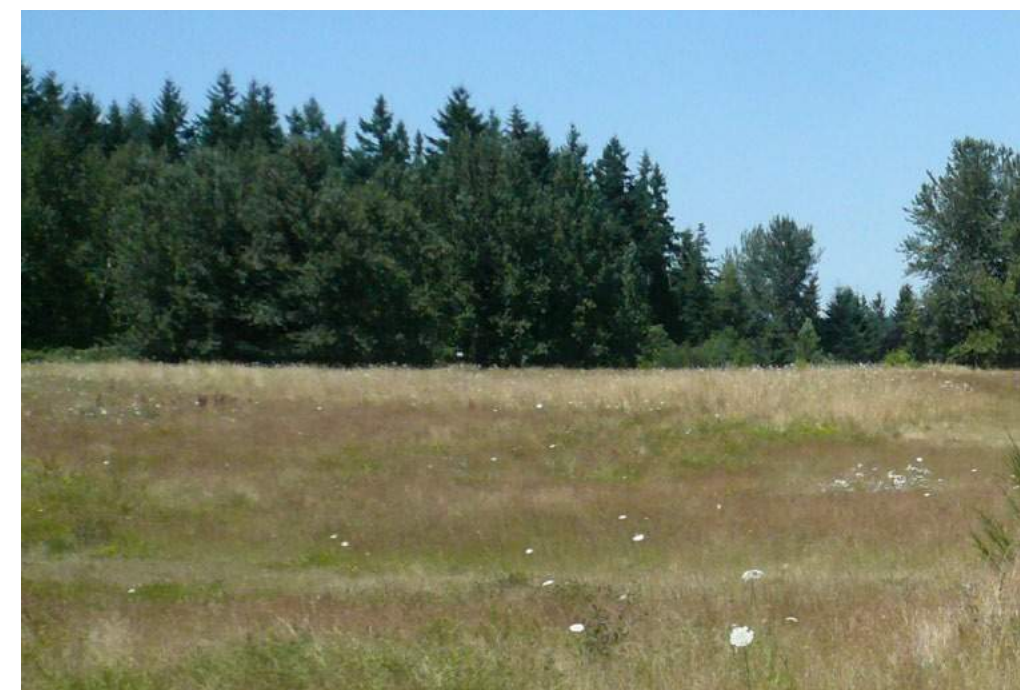

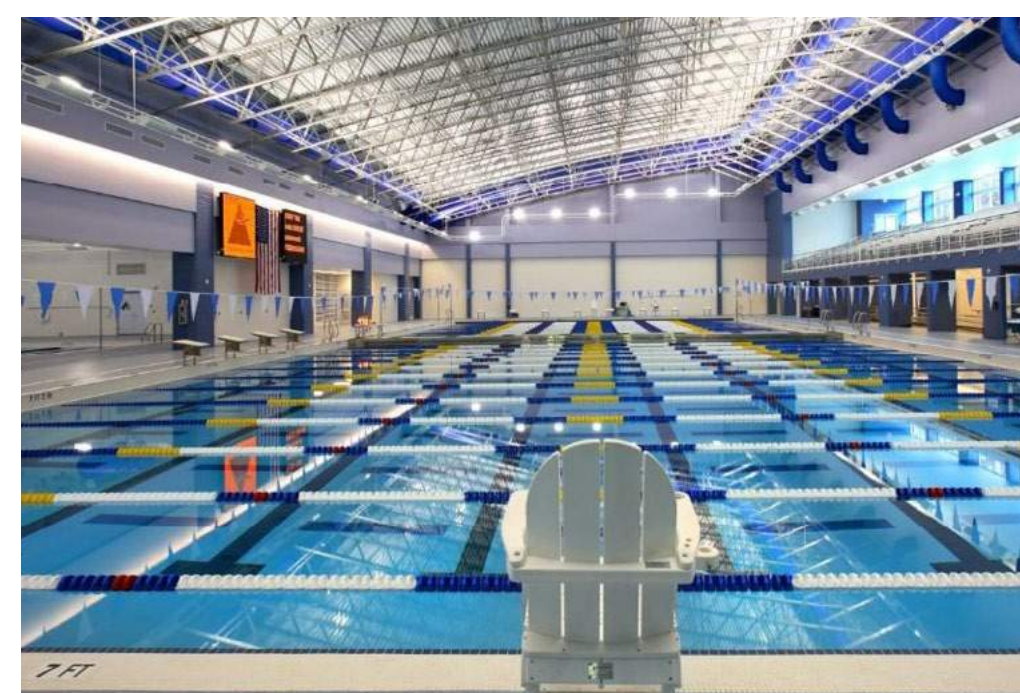

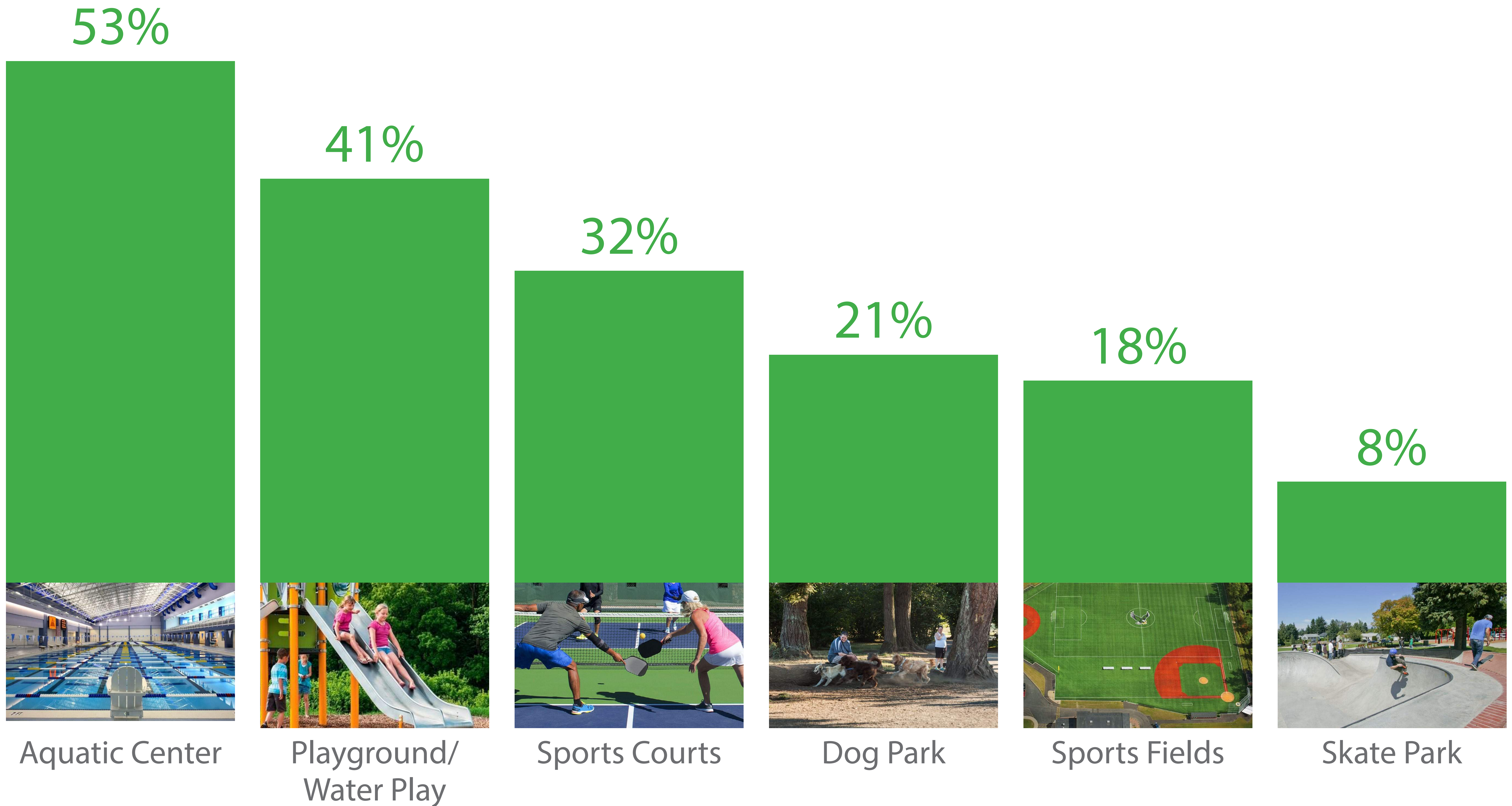

Summary of Alternative Concepts

Following Open House #1 and the survey, the design team developed multiple options based on the feedback received.

Modified Master Plan:

The master plan, based on community feedback prior to its completion in 2012, was focused on maximizing sports fields. The design included two multi-use field zones that were striped for two soccer fields and three baseball fields. Additionally, the concept includes multiple playground zones, a splash pad, basketball and support buildings for picnicking and restrooms. This concept preserved the majority of the forested portion of the site, and included trails, an amphitheater, and improvements to the existing ponds.

Based on the recent feedback, the team modified the previous master plan to remove one multi use field, replacing one soccer and one baseball field with two tennis courts and four pickle ball courts, as well as extending more habitat area into the west side of the site. The master plan concept, however, does not address the community's current desire for a community center and aquatic facility.

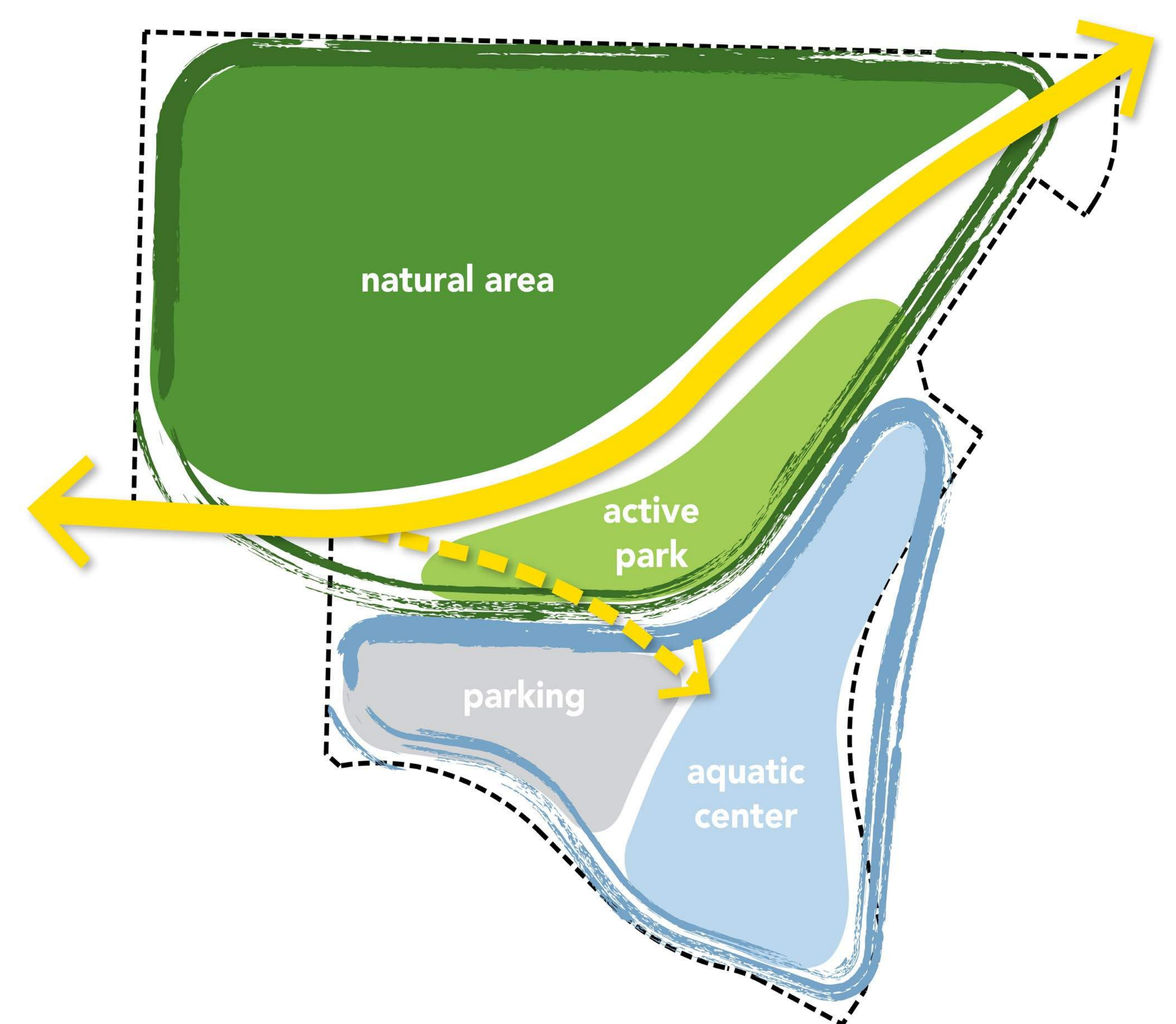

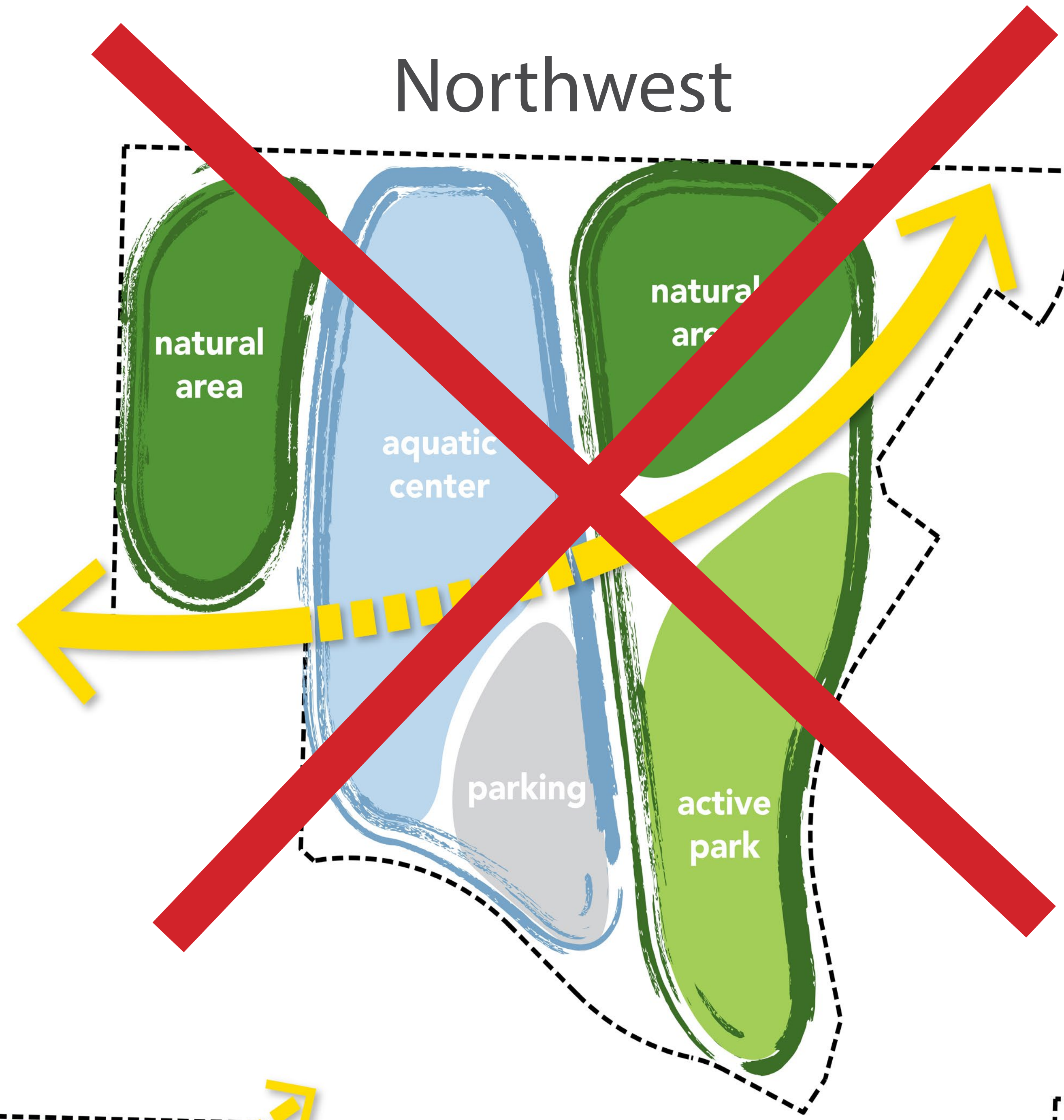

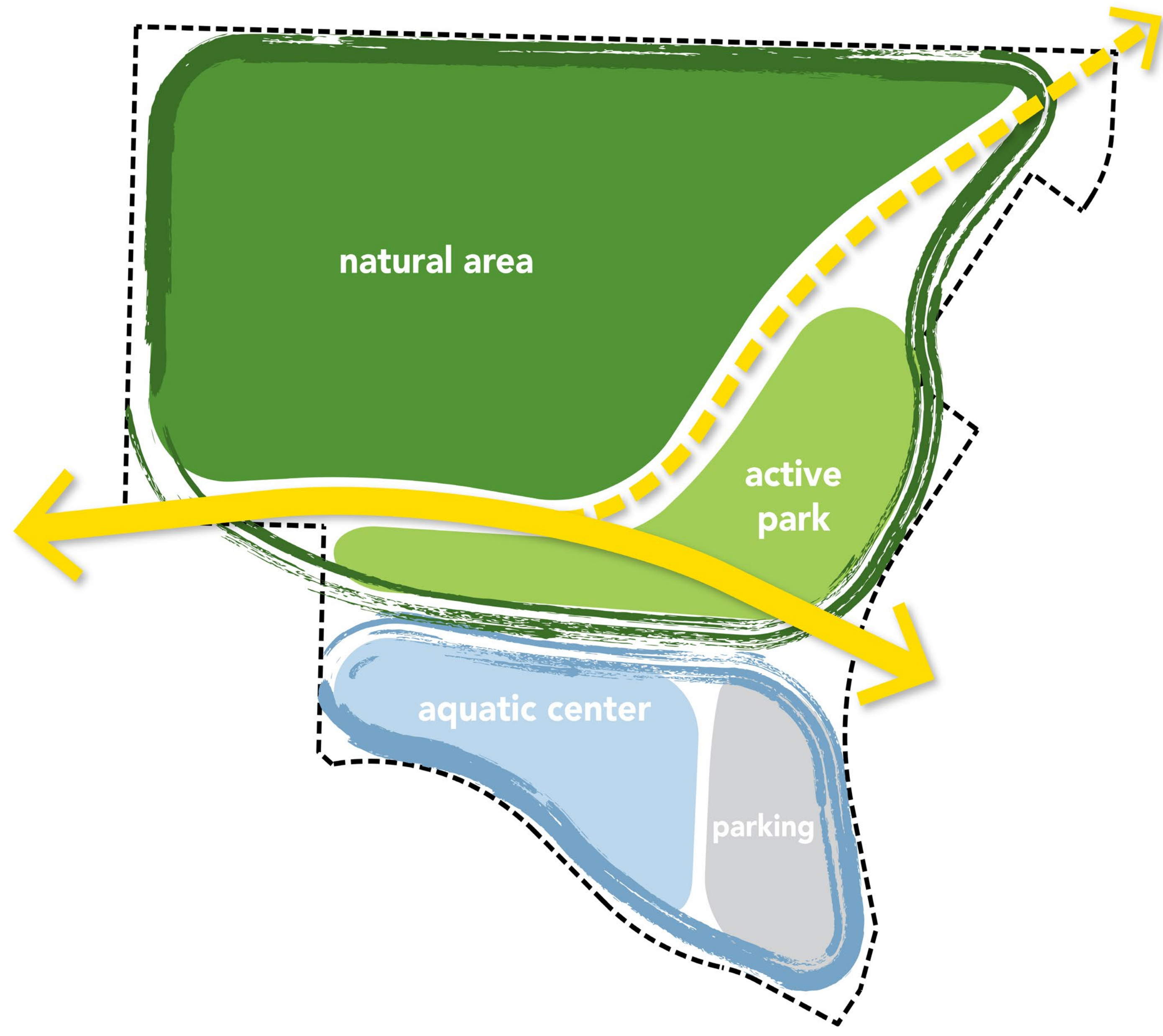


Potential Building Locations

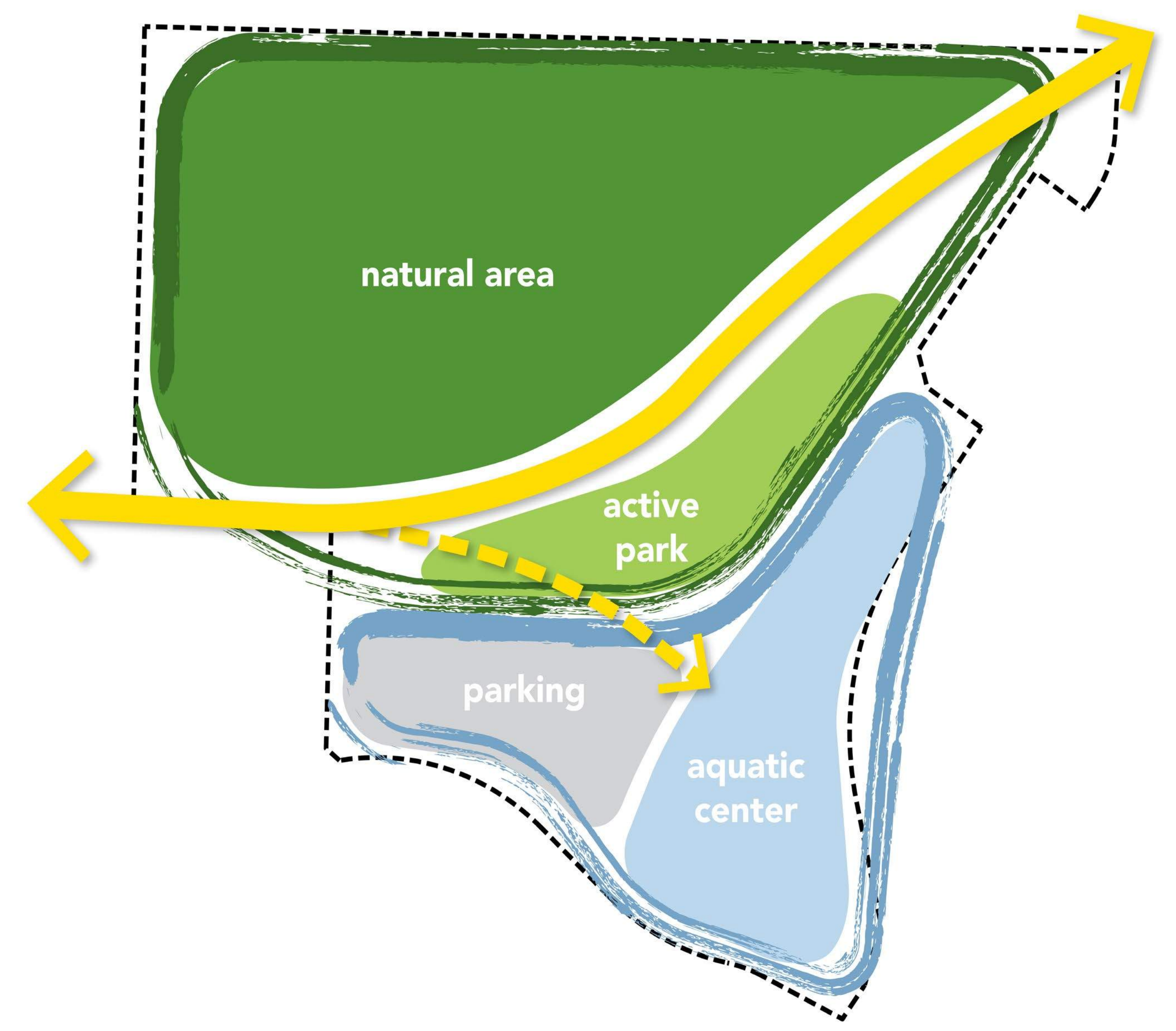

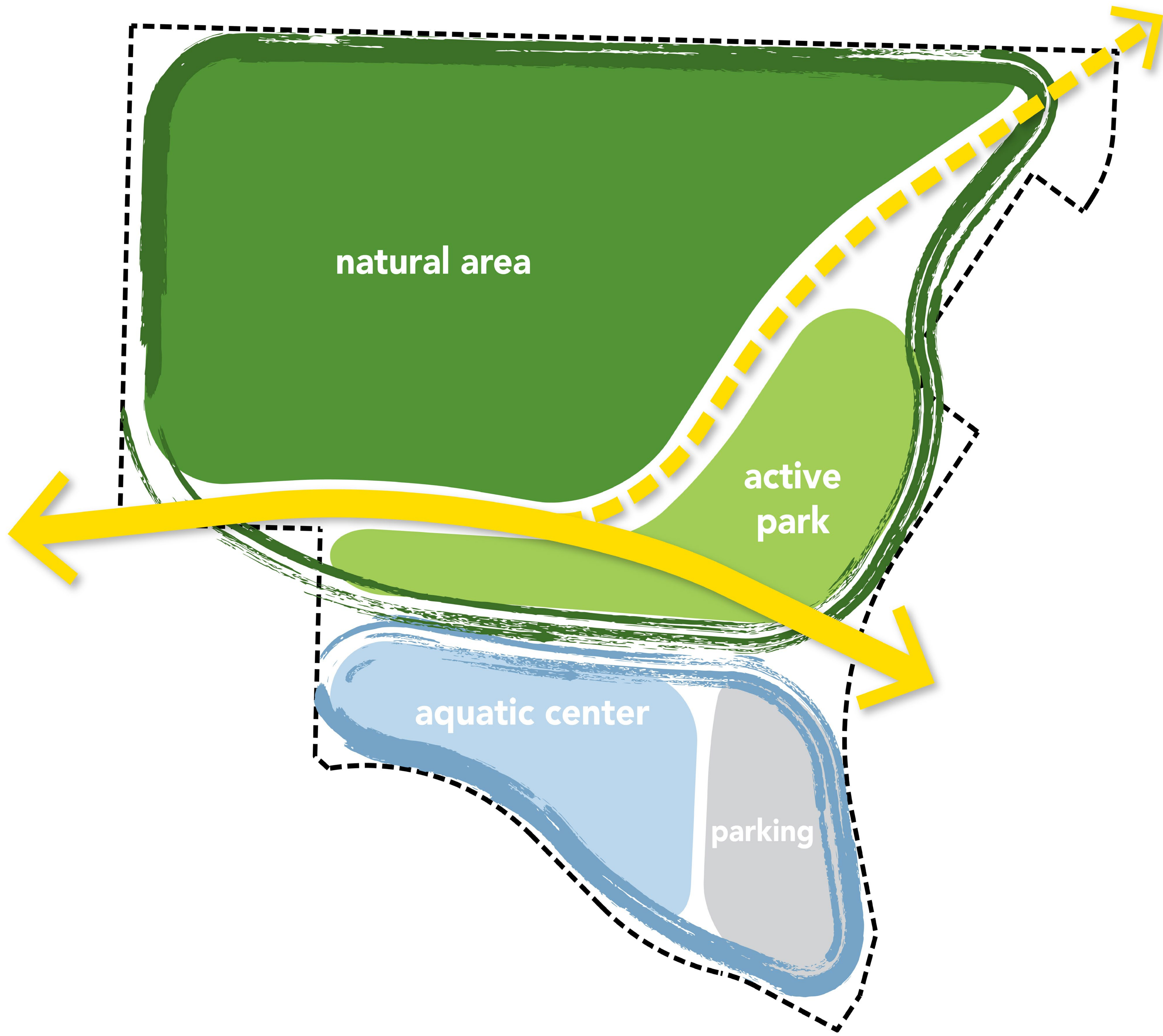

Summary of Alternative Concepts

Alternative #1:

This alternative includes a new community center and aquatic facility located along the south edge of the park site. The addition of the aquatic facility requires a minimum of 250 parking spaces on-site. In this concept, the parking is divided on both the east and west sides of the aquatic facility, allowing for more moderately sized lots. In addition to the aquatic facility, the plan includes a play area, outdoor splash pad, 3 pickleball courts, one multi use field with baseball and soccer, as well as areas for picnicking throughout the site. Additionally, this concept preserves the majority of the existing wooded areas and incorporates trails with community connections and area for picnicking.

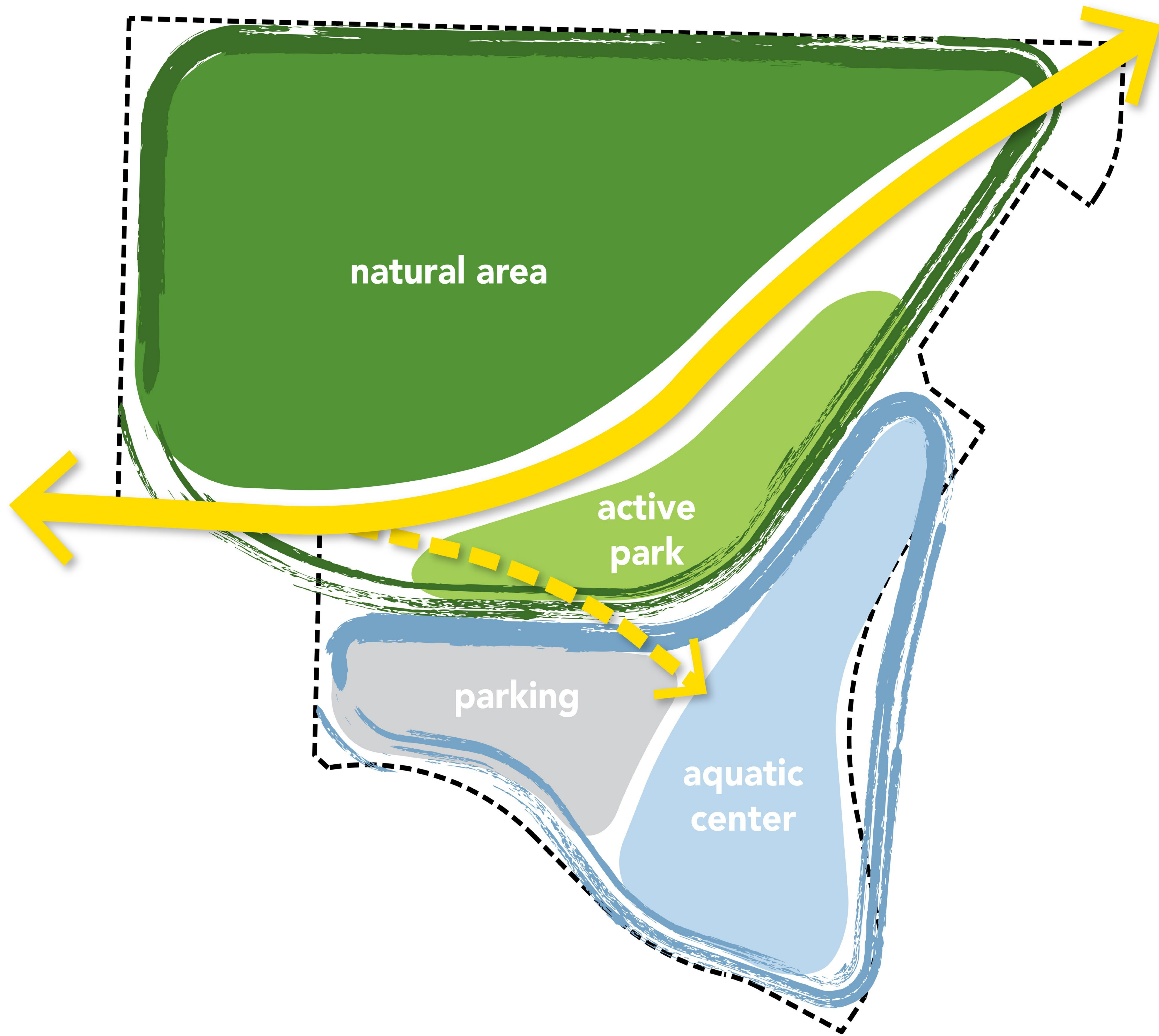

Summary of Alternative Concepts

Alternative #2:

Alternative #2 includes a new community center and aquatic facility along the east side of the park and proposes one consolidated parking area to the west of the building. The majority of the on-site programmatic activities are placed in the center of the site and overlook the wooded slopes. This option includes a play area, outdoor splash pad, 4 pickleball courts, basketball courts, and picnic space. The northern portion of the site is preserved with trails and picnicking incorporated into the wooded areas.

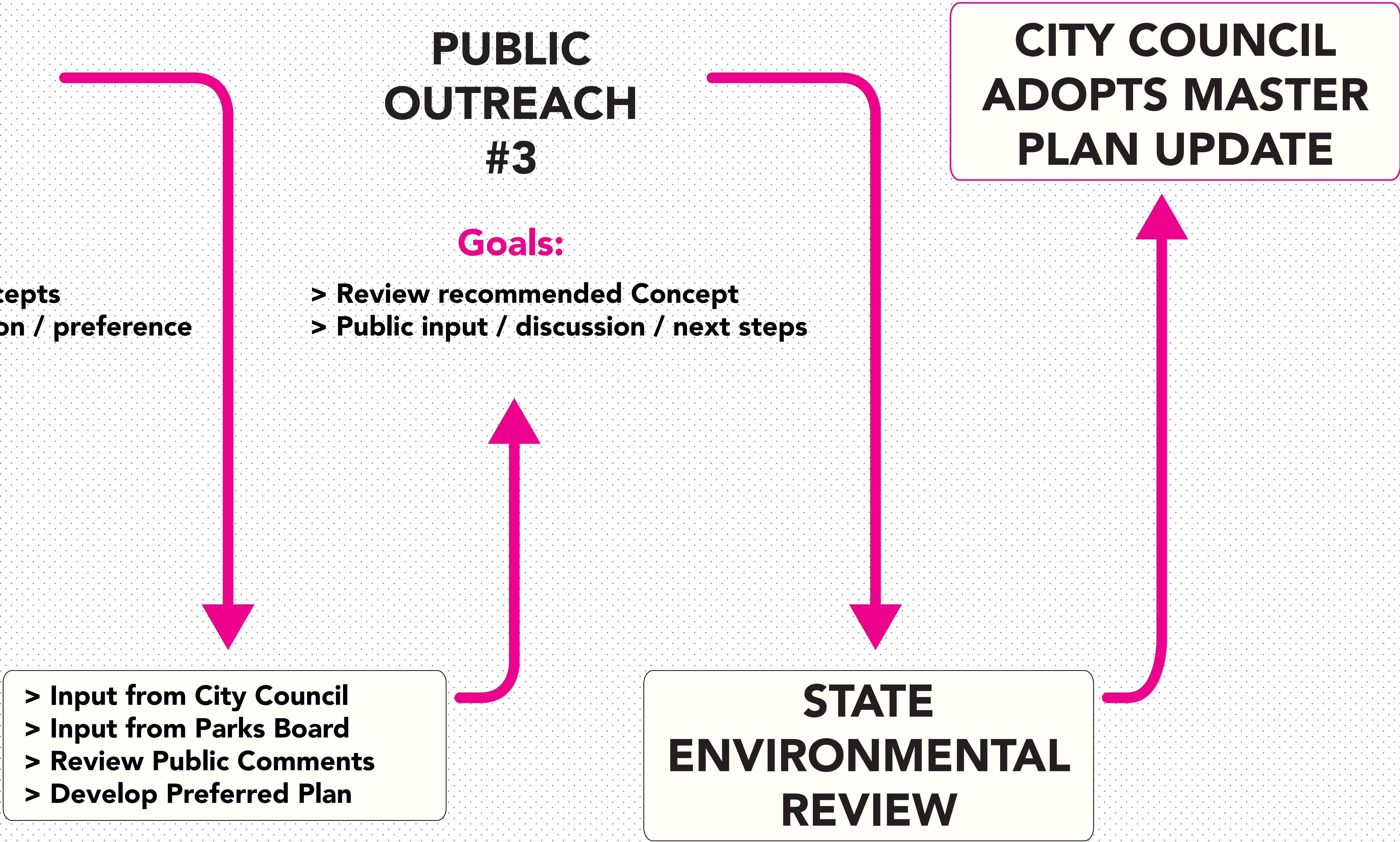
