## Bee Alert

- before crossing the street, stop at the sidewalk, or
 edge of the street
- always look left, right, and then left again
- continue looking until you have crossed the street
- watch out for cars backing up and turning
- make sure drivers see you; try to make eye contact before crossing


## Bee Careful

- walk facing traffic if you are not on the sidewalk
- obey signs and signals
- in rain or snow, allow extra time to cross the street
- don't run out between parked cars
- use extra caution when playing near the street-don't play in the street


## Bee Seen

- wear bright colored clothing during the day
- at night, carry a flashlight or wear reflective material


## Bee Alert, Bee Careful and Bee Seen



Look at the following pictures of Jack crossing the street. Put them in 1-2-3-4 order.


When the walk signal appears, look left, right, and left again.


If the hand starts blinking, you will still have time to cross. But, if you haven't started to cross, wait for the next walk signal.


Stop at the edge of the street and push the silver button. Wait for the walk signal.

- Be at the bus stop 5 minutes early.
- Wait for the bus away from traffic.
- Obey the driver at all times.

- Keep the bus clean.
- Stay in your seat at all times.
- Keep the aisle clear.
- Keep your head and hands in the bus.
- Don't throw things in or at the bus.

## CAUTION, DANGER, SAFE GAME RULES

 (2 or more players)- Deal all the cards face down equally to each player. Don't look!
- Take turns placing a card face up
- Youngest player goes first
- When 2 cards of the same type are shown, the first person to yell: "CAUTION" for caution cards "DANGER" for red cards "SAFE" for green cards wins the pile and shares a safety tip
- Start a new pile and repeat
- Player to collect all the cards wins!

-15 for not using the sidewalk. If possible, walk the dog on the sidewalk.


You walked on the edge of the sidewalk
-10 Walk in the middle of the sidewalk, away from the street.


You listened to loud music while walking to school
-20 Be attentive. Listen for the sounds of traffic.



You rode your bike AGAINST traffic
-15 you need to ride WITH traffic


You are about to cross a driveway
+10 if you looked both ways OR --15 if you didn't look either way


You ran in the crosswalk without looking for traffic
-10 please watch for traffic and walk


You walked facing traffic when not on a sidewalk
+15 for being alert around cars


You walked into a trash can while texting
-10 keep your phone in your pocket




- Always, always, always wear a bike safety helmet.
- Make sure your bike works well and doesn't need to be repaired.
- Wear bright colors during the day.
- Avoid riding in the dark.
- Wear reflective clothing and make sure your bike has reflectors and a headlight if you must ride in the dark.
- Know and follow the rules of the road.
- Know your hand signals.
- Ride with traffic.
- Watch for cars.

- Watch for hazards, like rocks, in the road.
- Don't ride next to each other when riding with a friend. Ride single file-one in front of the other.
- No stunt riding. It's dangerous.
