

# Pedbee's Traffic Safety Card Game and Activity Book




Did you know walking to school is a Bellevue SchoolPool activity?

**Traveling Through Your Neighborhood** 





- before crossing the street, stop at the sidewalk, or edge of the street
- always look left, right, and then left again
- continue looking until you have crossed the street
- watch out for cars backing up and turning
- make sure drivers see you; try to make eye contact before crossing


#### **Bee Careful**

- · walk facing traffic if you are not on the sidewalk
- obey signs and signals
- in rain or snow, allow extra time to cross the street
- don't run out between parked cars
- use extra caution when playing near the street—don't play in the street

#### **Bee Seen**


- wear bright colored clothing during the day
- · at night, carry a flashlight or wear reflective material




Traffic moves when the light is green. Sometimes it's hard for a kid to be seen. Play it safe. You know what I mean.




When the walk signal appears, look left, right, and left again.



Stop at the edge of the street and push the silver button. **Wait for the walk signal**.




If the hand starts blinking, you will still have time to cross. But, if you haven't started to cross, wait for the next walk signal.



When clear, start walking-don't run. **Keep looking and listening** as you cross.







There are lots of kids in the neighborhood. When your friends want to play with you before you cross the street, stop, look and listen.




**What's Wrong With This Picture?** 



- Be at the bus stop 5 minutes early.
- Wait for the bus away from traffic.
- Obey the driver at all times.
- Talk quietly.
- Don't eat, drink, or chew gum on the bus.
- Keep the bus clean.
- Stay in your seat at all times.
- Keep the aisle clear.
- Keep your head and hands in the bus.
- Don't throw things in or at the bus.
- Cross the street in front of the bus; never behind it.
- Stay out of the bus's danger zone.

You rode your bike with no hands

# TRAFFIC JAM GAME RULES (2 or more players)

- Deal all the cards face down equally to each player. Don't look!
- Players take turns flipping over a card
- Compare numbers. Player with the highest card keeps the cards played.
- Caution cards win over all cards
- If cards are the same number— TRAFFIC JAM!
- Each player places 1 card face down
- Flip over the next card. Compare.
- When all cards are played, shuffle and repeat until one player wins all the cards!

#### CAUTION, DANGER, SAFE GAME RULES (2 or more players)

- Deal all the cards face down equally to each player. Don't look!
- Take turns placing a card face up
- Youngest player goes first
- When 2 cards of the same type are shown, the first person to yell: "CAUTION" for caution cards "DANGER" for red cards "SAFE" for green cards wins the pile and shares a safety tip
- Start a new pile and repeat
- Player to collect all the cards wins!





- Always obey your bus driver.

-10 Walk in the middle of the sidewalk, away from the street.

-5 Be prepared. Make sure you have enough time to walk safely to school.




































Wrong-too far back

- Always, always wear a bike safety helmet.
- Make sure your bike works well and doesn't need to be repaired.
- Wear bright colors during the day.
- Avoid riding in the dark.
- Wear reflective clothing and make sure your bike has reflectors and a headlight if you must ride in the dark.
- Know and follow the rules of the road.





- Watch for hazards, like rocks, in the road.
- Don't ride next to each other when riding with a friend. Ride single file—one in front of the other.




Be extra careful when you ride your bike crossing the street with no traffic light, even when there's nothing in sight.


