REDUCING NEIGHBORHOOD CONGESTION

The City has heard of growing concerns about increased traffic congestion at intersections near or within neighborhoods. While there is currently no program dedicated to this issue, we are gathering input on locations throughout the City to better identify the extent of the problem.

Recent individual projects addressing congestion at or near neighborhoods include a new signal at Lakemont Boulevard and Cougar Mountain Way (2015) and a new signal at Lakemont Boulevard and 164th Avenue SE (2016).


Example Congested Intersections Near Neighborhoods:



150th Ave SE & Newport Way




156th Ave SE & Lake Hills Blvd
