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

West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE, Phase 2 SE 200 Block to NE 800 Block

Project Description: The City has begun design and initial field data collection to construct the next phase of the West Lake Sammamish Parkway (WLSP) Project. Phase 2 parkway improvements will add a multipurpose pathway and landscaping strips to the west side of the parkway between NE 800 Block to SE 200 Block (with additional water main work to SE 1700 block



for the City's Utility Department).



Phase 2 roadway improvements will be consistent with Phase 1 improvements constructed in 2013 between I-90 and SE 34th Street. This section of the Parkway was chosen because it overlaps with planned watermain improvements and its close proximity to potential detour routes. This section of Parkway is also expected to have fewer retaining walls and environmental impacts compared with other sections of the parkway.

Roadway improvements are illustrated in the attached conceptual roadway cross-section, and include the reconstruction of the roadway pavement, the installation of an eight-foot-to-ten-foot multiuse pathway (west side), a zero-to-five-foot landscaped buffer, two ten-foot-wide travel lanes and a four-foot shoulder on the east side of the parkway. The project also includes replacing existing sewer lines and installing new illumination, landscaping, irrigation, storm drainage and water quality treatment. This roadway project has a budget of \$8 million.

Utilities Department Work: The City's Utilities Department has already completed preliminary design of water main replacement work on the parkway. Their work includes replacing the water main, increasing system pressure, installing pressure reducing valves, and upgrading a segment

of a force main sewer. The design and construction of the water main replacement and the roadway improvement will be coordinated and combined into one construction contract. Combining the construction of the water main work with the roadway work will minimize overall construction duration along the parkway and decrease impacts to the public. The Utilities Department will be contacting homeowners in certain areas regarding the need to protect their plumbing from higher pressures. This utilities project has a budget of \$3.5 million.

Construction Schedule: Construction for Phase 2 roadway work and water main replacement work is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2019. When the roadway work is completed, approximately two miles of the 5.5 miles planned parkway improvements will be completed.

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
