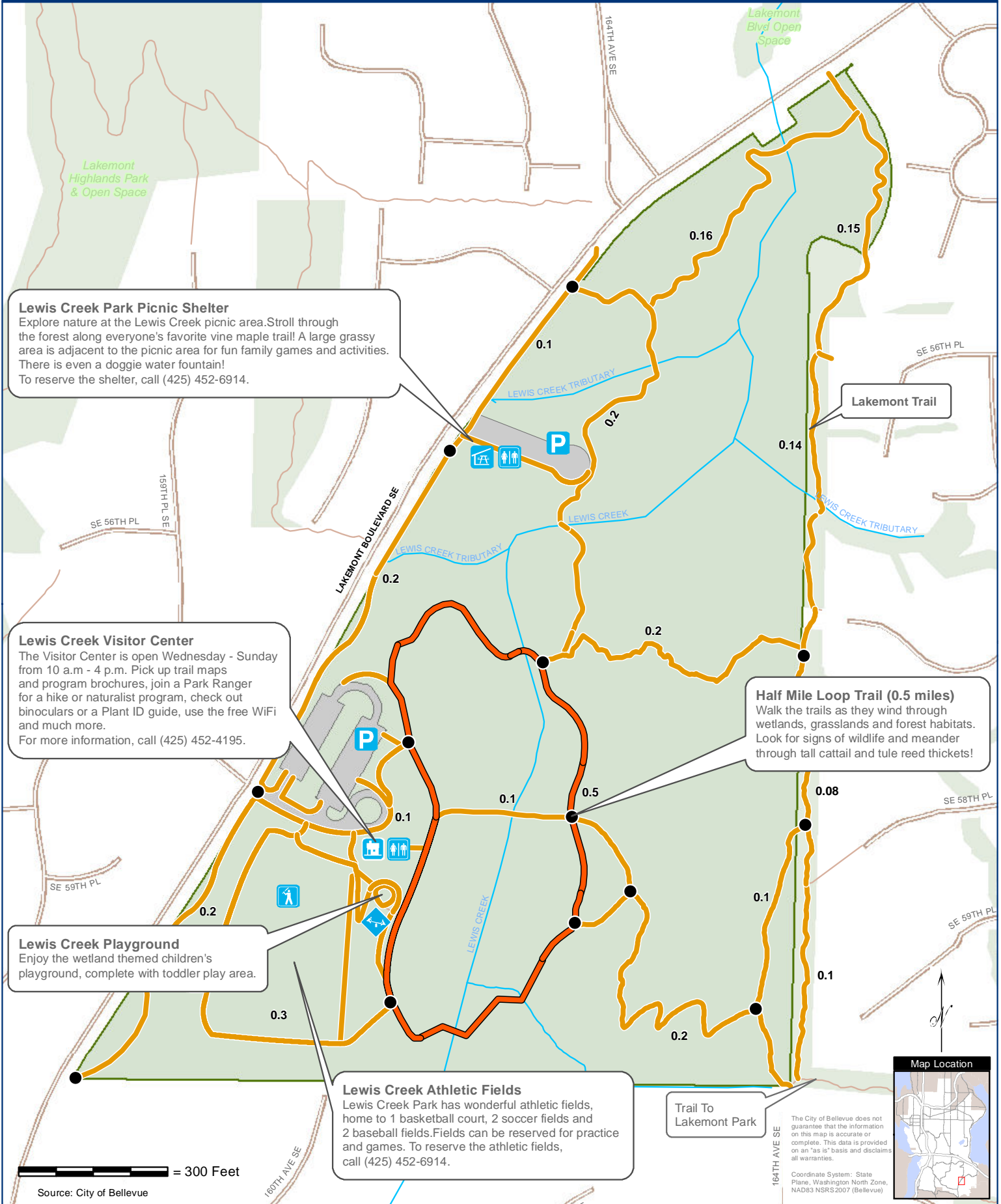

Half Mile Loop Trail (0.5 miles)

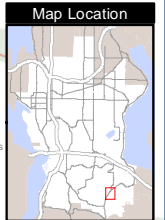
Walk the trails as they wind through wetlands, grasslands and forest habitats. Look for signs of wildlife and meander through tall cattail and tule reed thickets!
