South Bellevue Community Center (SBCC) staff is excited to host the May Park Board Meeting on Tuesday, May 13 and showcase our wonderful facility and programs and services we provide to our diverse community. As part of the evening's agenda, staff will lead a 30-minute tour of the Bellevue Challenge Course and new Zip Tour, prior to your meeting.
