Subject: Golf Operations
(Informational – no Board action requested)

At the Tuesday May 14, 2013 Parks & Community Services Board meeting, I will present information about the Bellevue and Crossroads Golf Courses. I will provide an overview of the golf operations that includes the business model, history, programming, capital improvements and future plans.

The Bellevue Golf Course opened in 1969. It is an 18 hole par 71 layout that remains one of the busiest courses in the State, averaging over 60,000 rounds of golf a year. The Crossroads Par 3 was purchased in 1975 as part of a Parks land acquisition. This 9 hole par 3 layout can be played in less than an hour and is an excellent place to work on your short game or to learn the game of golf.
