On Tuesday, September 13, 2016 at the Parks & Community Services Board meeting, I will present information on Crossroads Community Center. This presentation will introduce Crossroads Community Center's vision and mission, along with our broad spectrum of programs and services, with an emphasis on the Crossroads Afterschool Youth Academy (CAYA).

Crossroads Community Center opened in 1981, and provides a diverse, accessible community center for all ages to participate in recreational and educational programs and activities including the arts, health and wellness classes, cultural and community events and civic engagement opportunities.

The Center supports youth and teen programs through the CAYA program model, with a focus on serving low to moderate family income levels. It provides basic support services in partnership for the community's most vulnerable citizens in the Crossroads neighborhood. Crossroads Center also offers private community rentals and serves as a citywide emergency shelter.
