

**B7-Revised Alternative:** The City of Bellevue invites you to our second public meeting to see and comment on our team's preliminary work on the city's B7-Revised alternative. This alternative is a variant of the B7 alternative studied in Sound Transit's Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) and Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS) for the East Link project. The study consists of conceptual engineering, environmental screening, ridership analysis, and cost estimating to provide an objective "apples to apples" comparison to the Sound Transit B7 alternative.

At this public meeting you will have the opportunity to learn about and comment on the preliminary work on the B7-Revised alternative. During the public meeting there will a presentation on the study's preliminary work at 5:15 pm, which will be repeated at 6:15 pm. The open house portion of the public meeting will run the entire length of the meeting. The presentation and open house will cover **alignment, station and park-n-ride layouts, and environmental, private property, and traffic issues.**
