





- General support for Alternative C;
- Some felt a 1-acre OLA better reflected a neighborhood facility, others felt it was right sized;
- Concern from some neighbors that feedback didn't represent neighborhood interests.



Summary of Comments Received 58 comments

The majority of comments support the preferred plan but want the off leash area increased to the Option C size of 1.6 – 1.75 acres

Preferred Park Plan Features

- Picnic shelter & landscaped lawn 1.5-acre
- Adventure play area with hillside mound
- Fenced off-leash area with shelter, gated entries, water, kiosk, grass surface with drainage improvements and small dog area 1.5-acre
- Loop trail systems & connections with overlooks
- Street frontage improvements & crosswalk
- Paved entry drive, parking, restroom & security lighting
