# Construction Alert

108th Ave NE Complete Street Project

June 2020

The Bellevue Transportation Department will be constructing mobility improvements along 108th Ave NE from south of Main Street to NE 12th Street. These improvements will make it safer and more convenient for people walking and rolling, bicycling, riding transit and driving. The project will:

- Improve the existing bikeway by creating continuous bike lanes and adding bike signals.
- Upgrade existing mid-block pedestrian crossings.
- Add red pavement markings at the Bellevue Transit Center to better highlight bus space.
- Enhance existing floating bus platform near NE 2nd Street.
- Resurface pavement at NE 2nd Street intersection.
- Designate more passenger loading/unloading curb space.
- Modify traffic signal operations to improve safety.

## What to expect

- Construction begins as early as mid-June and is anticipated to be complete by September.
- Expect daily intermittent lane closures along the corridor. Follow detours.


- Approved work hours:Monday Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Intermittent street closures during weekends may be needed to maintain construction schedule.
- Some work is weather dependent.
- Construction schedules are subject to change and often do.

### **Funding**

Funding comes from the Neighborhood Safety, Connectivity and Congestion Levy, the Pavement and Bridge Management Program and other city programs. Estimated cost is \$1.3 million.
