I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Chair Neiman.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Boardmember Reil and second by Boardmember Bergeron to approve the September 3, 2014 LEOFF 1 Disability Board regular meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously (3-0).

Motion by Boardmember Reil and second by Boardmember Bergeron to approve the Special Claims as presented.

Boardmembers discussed Member #71's claim for an oximeter. Ms. Dillon noted that the Member has pulmonary fibrosis which makes it necessary for him to be on oxygen 24/7. A nurse at Swedish Hospital recommended an oximeter so the Member could keep track of the oxygen level in his blood. However, Boardmembers expressed concern because this device was recommended by a nurse rather than the Member's physician. Ms. Windsor added that the device may be logical and prudent; however, set policies and procedures need to be followed.

At the question, motion carried unanimously (3-0) to deny Member #71's claim. Boardmembers directed staff to contact Member #71 to request a prescription from the Member's physician so the claim can be reconsidered.

The pre-approved recurring long-term care claims were reviewed and included in the Board packet.
