## IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Councilmember Lee and second by Boardmember Reil to approve the October 7, 2009 Disability Board Regular Meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously (4-0).

Motion by Boardmember Bergeron and second by Councilmember Lee to approve the November 4, 2009 Disability Board Regular Meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously (4-0).

## V. CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR DISABILITY ALLOWANCES

## A. Applications for Disability Allowances

Motion by Boardmember Bergeron and second by Boardmember Reil to approve the Applications for Disability Allowances as presented. Motion carried unanimously (4-0).
B. Applications for Disability Allowances Greater than 1 month

Motion by Boardmember Bergeron and second by Boardmember Reil to approve the Applications for Disability Allowances greater than one month.

Boardmembers discussed the duty relatedness of Member \#47's claim and determined that the leave application for the Member's disability, since June 10, 2009, is duty related. Ms. Dillon clarified that the retirement of Member \#47 is not duty related.

At the question, motion carried unanimously (4-0) to approve Disability Allowances Greater than 1 month.

Boardmembers discussed Member \#71's claim for the blood pressure monitor. Ms. Dillon clarified that the monitor was recommended by the Member's physician. Similar claims will be treated on a case-by-case basis.

Ms. Dillon clarified that treatment for Member \#22's abscess tooth is necessary before the Member's scheduled surgery. This is a covered claim.

At the question, motion carried unanimously (4-0) to approve the Special Claims.

At the previous Board meeting, Councilmember Lee questioned the discount rate used in the LEOFF 1 Actuarial Study. Calculating the study with the suggested $5 \%$ discount would be contrary to the professional actuary's opinion and not realistic.
