RESOLUTION NO. 138

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving Ordinance No. 2837 adopted by the Bellevue City Council relating to regulating the sale of drug paraphernalia.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington did pass Ordinance No. 2837 on the 12th day of May, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Ordinance falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040, and

WHEREAS, following public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on June 3, 1980, the Community Council did vote to approve Bellevue Ordinance No. 2837.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue, Washington:



Section 2. Ordinance No. 2837 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.


