RESOLUTION NO. 204

A RESOLUTION amending the rules and procedures of the Community Council regarding the election of officers; and amending Section 5 of Resolution No. 191:

THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Resolution No. 191 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. Officers

There shall be a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman elected from the membership of the Community Council. The annual election shall take place each year at the February meeting of the Community Council, or as soon thereafter as an election may be held. A candidate must receive at least three votes to be elected. The term of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall Commence on their election and shall terminate on the election of a Chairman or Vice-Chairman at the next following annual election. A Chairman or Vice-Chairman may be re-elected. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings. In his absence, the Vice-Chairman shall preside. They shall retain their right to vote on all actions. If neither the Chairman nor Vice-Chairman is present at a meeting and a quorum is present, a Chairman pro tempore shall be selected by a majority of those present and shall then preside.
