RESOLUTION NO. 25

A RESOLUTION requesting that the City Council withdraw approval of the design plans for the Eastgate Interchange, and that the State Highway Commission review and reconsider the plans in the light of new data.

WHEREAS, it now appears that the City Council's original approval of the design of the Eastgate Interchange was made upon data which was incomplete and inaccurate for the purpose of assessing traffic needs in the area, and,

WHEREAS, new data is now available in regard to traffic counts and other matters pertinent to projections and predictions basic to good design, and,

WHEREAS, the Interchange design may produce intolerable traffic burdens upon the residential community to the north, and,

WHEREAS, the East Bellevue Community Council after hearing and considering the new data, in Public Hearing on August 10, 1971, has determined that reconsideration is in the best interests of the residents of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation, now therefore,

THE EAST BELLEVUE COMMUNITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council is hereby respectfully requested to withdraw their approval of said plans.

Section 2. The City Council is hereby respectfully requested to communicate said withdrawal to the State Highway Commission, and in so doing, request that the State Highway Commission review and reconsider the plans by further Public Hearings on the matter.

Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.
