## RESOLUTION NO. 272

A RESOLUTION of the East Bellevue Community Council approving City Council Ordinance No. 4028 relating to general land use provisions; amending Bellevue City Code (Land Use Code) 20.10.440, 20.20.125, 20.20.140, 20.20.590.K.10, 20.20.920, 20.30A.150, 20.35.245, 20.50.010, 20.50.012, 20.50.014, 20.50.022, 20.50.024, 20.50.036, 20.50.040, 20.50.044, 20.50.046 and 20.50.052; and adding new sections 20.20.730 and 20.40.415 to the Bellevue City Code (Land Use Code)

WHEREAS, on July 17, 1989 the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington passed Ordinance No. 4028 relating to general land use provisions; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of said Ordinance falls within the jurisdiction of the East Bellevue Community Council pursuant to RCW 35.14.040; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing held before the East Bellevue Community Council on August 1, 1989, the Community Council voted to approve Bellevue Ordinance No. 4028,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Community Council of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation of the City of Bellevue resolves as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Findings, Conclusions and Conditions adopted by the Bellevue City Council relative to Ordinance No. 4028 are hereby adopted by the East Bellevue Community Council as though fully set forth herein.

<u>Section 2.</u> Ordinance No. 4028 of the Bellevue City Council is hereby approved.

Section 3. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this Resolution, to file the same and to keep the same on file in her office. The Clerk is further directed to distribute certified or conformed copies of this Resolution to the Bellevue City Council, the Bellevue Planning Department, and the Department of Design and Development.
