RESOLUTION NO. 75

A RESOLUTION approving City Council Ordinance No. 2266 which reclassifies property located on the south side of N.E. 8th at approximately 144th Avenue N.E. upon application of Jack and Jean Eller and William Mundt.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, did pass Ordinance No. 2266 on the 8th day of December, 1975, and,

WHEREAS, said ordinance reclassifies property located on the south side of N.E. 8th at approximately 144th Avenue N.E., from MR-3S, R-20 and R-7.2 to MR-3L, and,

WHEREAS, after due study and deliberation, in a public meeting held December 9, 1975, the East Bellevue Community Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, finds Ordinance No. 2266 to be in the best interest of the residents of the East Bellevue Community Municipal Corporation, now therefore,

Section 2. The Clerk is hereby directed to certify the original of this resolution, to file the same, and to keep the same on file in her office.


