What's coming



Left turns will be prohibited from southbound 128th Ave SE to eastbound SE 32nd St from 4-7 pm, Monday-Friday.



Right turns will be prohibited from southbound 128th Ave SE to westbound SE 30th St from 4-7 pm, Monday-Friday.

Installation planned for early June. Applies to all motorists. Bikes and buses exempt. Signs will be installed for six months to evaluate effectiveness and gather public input.
