CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3999

AN ORDINANCE regarding traffic; and extending the expiration date of Ordinance No. 3948, as previously extended by Ordinance No. 3988, establishing Levels of Service on the street system of the City.

WHEREAS, on September 6, 1988, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 3948, regarding the establishment of level of service requirements on the street system of the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3948 added a Section 23.10.034 to the Bellevue City Code, which provides that applications under Land Use Code Process I or Process II (excluding applications for reclassifications of property) and building permit applications (excluding applications for tenant improvements) cannot be approved unless designated level of service requirements are maintained on affected portions of the City street system; and

WHEREAS, on September 6, 1988, the City Council also adopted Resolution No. 5053, stating the Council's intent to establish a public process to determine how traffic impacts from new development will be regulated and/or funded; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 5053 also established a Traffic Impact Task Force to develop programs, regulations and financing mechanisms to assure that transportation improvements are constructed as needed to support ongoing growth and development, to identify appropriate standards for transportation levels, and to identify financing mechanisms which allocate costs for transportation improvements equitably; and

WHEREAS, since its establishment, the Task Force has been pursuing its charge under Resolution No. 5053 and has periodically briefed the Council Subcommittee formed under the Resolution to oversee the work of the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the original schedule for adoption of a permanent traffic ordinance anticipated that such an ordinance could be adopted and in effect prior to the March 6, 1989 expiration date of Ordinance No. 3948; and

WHEREAS, because of the need to develop and analyze additional financial data related to the development of transportation facilities, it was necessary, by Ordinance No. 3988, to extend the expiration date of Ordinance No. 3948 to April 15, 1989; and

WHEREAS, completion of work on the permanent ordinance will require additional time; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary to extend the expiration date of Ordinance No. 3948 to June 30, 1989, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 3948, as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3988, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Expiration. This Ordinance shall expire and cease to be in effect on June 30, 1989.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


