

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5982

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Comprehensive Plan of the City of Bellevue, as required and adopted pursuant to the Growth Management Act of 1990, as amended (Chapter 36.70A RCW); adopting 2010 amendments to the Comprehensive Plan known as the Transportation-related CPA, amending the Transportation Element at Figure TR.3; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2010, the City Council initiated the Transportation-related Comprehensive Plan Amendment ("CPA") to include modifying the Transportation Element at Figure TR.3 – Street Classifications; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held public hearings on October 13, 2010, with regard to the Transportation Element at Figure TR.3 – Existing Arterials and Freeways with Street Classifications to classify the existing NE 10th Street between 112th Avenue NE and 116th Avenue NE as Minor Arterial CPA proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended that the City Council approve such proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Transportation Element at Figure TR.3 – Existing Arterials and Freeways with Street Classifications CPA concurrently with the other 2010 Transportation-related Comprehensive Plan amendment proposals; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Transportation Element at Figure TR.3 – Existing Arterials and Freeways with Street Classifications CPA satisfies the decision criteria established in Part 20.30(I) of the Land Use Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act (Chapter 43.21C RCW) and the City Environmental Procedures Code (Chapter 22.02 BCC); now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Transportation Element, Figure TR.3 of the Comprehensive Plan, is hereby amended as set forth in Attachment 1.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication. This ordinance, the Transportation Element, and

the city's Comprehensive Plan shall be available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk.






FIGURE TR.3
