A RESOLUTION supporting Bellevue School District Propositions 1 (educational programs and operations levy) and 2 (technology and capital projects levies) on the February 9, 2010 special election ballot.

WHEREAS, levy requests of the Bellevue School District for its Educational Programs and Operations and Technology and Capital Projects levies will be submitted to the voters at the February 9, 2010 election; and

WHEREAS, the Educational Programs and Operations levy replaces an expiring levy and funds students' educational needs and school operations ; and

WHEREAS, the Technology and Capital Projects levy funds capital administrative expenses and other capital project expenditures to allow the District to continue modernizing District facilities by acquiring , developing, installing, and implementing computer technology systems, facilities and projects for operations and instruction; and

WHEREAS, the District has shown a strong commitment to excellence in education by establishing a state-wide reputation for quality schools; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to express support for the continuing efforts of the District to provide excellence in education and to support the District's efforts to provide the necessary funding to carry on with those efforts; now, therefore;


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
