#### Instructions

#### 1. Who should fill out this form?

Only businesses on non-reporting status or who filed returns below the quarterly minimum threshold during the calendar year are required to reconcile their taxable income annually. The annual reconciliation confirms a business is below the threshold.

### 2. How do I claim my refund?

You must file your final year end return and pay any tax owed. Please do not amend your final return to include any refund due for previous periods from this reconciliation.

Pease allow up to 90 days for review and processing. We will mail the refund to the address on record.

3. How do I calculate my taxable income? Refer to Bellevue City Code (BCC) 4.09.

#### 4. Will there be interest?

Interest will apply to both refunds and additional amounts due. The City will automatically include interest in refunds. If additional tax is due, the City will notify businesses of the amount of interest due.

# 5. What if I have questions about this reconciliation?

 How do I report additional tax due? If your current filing status is nonreporting please file an annual return by January 31<sup>st</sup> and report amounts from lines 1, 2 and 3 on the multi-purpose tax return.

If your current filing status is monthly, quarterly or annual you must file a return by January 31<sup>st</sup> and report the amount on line 8 in column 2. Do not take additional deductions as this amount is net of deductions already taken. You may file returns online at www.filelocal-wa.gov.

#### 7. Instructions by line

Line 1 – If you filed returns in 2018 these are the amounts reported in column 2, lines 1-7 of each return.

If you did not file returns, enter your total annual gross receipts for all tax classifications listed on the multi-purpose tax return.

Line 2 – If you filed returns in 2018, these are the amounts reported in column 3, lines 1-7. If you did not file returns see schedule D for allowable deductions by tax classification

Line 6 – If you filed returns in 2018, these are the amounts reported in column 4, lines 1-7. Otherwise enter zero
