





## City Council direction

- Graduated affordability approach, as used in Seattle

- Additional items:

  - Reference to King County administrative fees





## Graduated affordability approach

 Graduated affordability requirements correspond to the size of the rental unit


	Studio	1	2
		bedroom	bedroom
Seattle	65%	75%	85%
Alternative			
Downtown RTA	60%	70%	80%
Other RTAs	55%	65%	75%

 Seattle staff believe effect on 2-bedroom units is not significant



## Feasibility analysis findings

- Using Seattle
   affordability levels in
   Bellevue results in high
   public cost compared to
   public benefit
- Using alternative affordability levels results in more balanced public cost and benefit






## Comparison of approaches

Graduated affordability	Single affordability level	
No observable impact on 2- bedroom housing production	No impact on 2-bedroom housing production	
Relatively more complex approach	Relatively simpler approach	
Differs from current MFTE structure	Matches current MFTE structure	

### Two-bedroom units

- Seattle
  - Graduated affordability
  - Incentive provisions
  - Staff report no noticeable change
- Bellevue
  - 15% requirement
  - Consistent with market to date

 Potential for administrative discretion for flexibility subject to specific criteria

Update language





## Council direction requested

- Amend MFTE requirement for affordable units in Downtown
  - 20% of units affordable to household incomes at 70% of median
- Allow for consideration of submittal of application after first building permit
- Revise reference to King County administrative fee
