Mission

Founded in 1993, the mission of CFH is to end homelessness on the Eastside by helping men make the transition from life on the street



Programs

Outreach

Connects individuals living on the street to needed resources.

Winter Shelters

Provides emergency shelter and meals from November–April serving 80–95 people each night.

Day Centers

Provides respite, with meals, showers, and laundry serving 50-75 each day.

Permanent Shelter

Prepares men with the skills and resources they need to establish stable housing.

Case Management

Provides one-on-one support from a case manager who works as client's advocate.

Housing

Includes subsidized apartments and shared homes for the men we serve.

64% of clients exit from shelter to housing

95% of clients remain in stable housing after two years

30,000 bed nights provided and **70,000** meals served in 2015

- Year round, fully staffed
- Shelter 5PM-8AM daily
- Day center 8AM-5PM daily
- Police and neighborhood coordination
- Meals, showers, laundry, computers, mental health & addiction support, employment assistance, housing, legal assistance, case management
