



Goff Creek Restoration and Open Space Planning Options

Improvements to Goff Creek are part of the City of Bellevue's long-term vision for Bel-Red. Goff Creek restoration and open space options are being discussed now to inform planning for light rail and are intended to support and be compatible with future redevelopment. Stream restoration would be timed to occur with redevelopment, likely in the 2020-2030 time period, not to displace existing businesses. Some improvements associated with Sound Transit's work could occur sooner. A discussion of options at this time is intended to:

- Establish a long term vision to restore Goff Creek
- Establish a long term vision to provide pedestrian connections
- Create natural amenities that attract future residential redevelopment
- Establish options that maintain the feasibility of future redevelopment of specific parcels
- Inform the ongoing Bel-Red station area planning work
- Inform Sound Transit light rail planning and identify priorities for mitigation
