

Visit Kelsey Creek Farm

Animal viewing 9:30am-3:30pm daily. Hiking/jogging trails, picnic areas, playground, wetlands and play fields. No entrance fee; donations always welcome. Dogs and other pets must be on leash at all times when visiting the park. All pets are prohibited from the area surrounding the barns. Groups of 10+ must pre-register. For large groups of 30+ there will be a \$30 fee. Picnic shelter rentals for small social gatherings or groups of 50 or less. Call or email for reservations and information.

GROUP GUITAR LESSONS

This course will teach guitar lessons for both beginners and those with some experience. By the end of the course, students should have mastered basic, dominant 7, and barre chords; major and minor scales; memorization of every note on the neck of the guitar; be comfortable with alternate picking; know and understand building blocks of both blues and rock songs; and play a selection of well-known popular songs. Music theory will be introduced (painless!) at appropriate points during the course to create those "a-ha!" moments which provide students an understanding of music.
