

Phantom Lake Walkway

2.6 Miles

This is a wonderful trail for escaping from the office, a lunchtime jog or an after-school walk to give the kids an alternative to afternoon TV. The loop is a 2.6-mile asphalt path designed to handle high density use. Lots of trees along the path create a relaxing atmosphere. You'll hear songbirds and see squirrels scurrying up the trunks of trees. On 168th Avenue the loop connects to Weowna Park trailhead and on to Lake Sammamish. Some of the oldest and biggest trees in Bellevue grow here. The Phantom Lake Loop connects with the Lake Hills Greenbelt at 156th Avenue SE and SE 16th Street.
