What is Bellevue Essentials?

Bellevue Essentials is an 11-week civic engagement program that will open your eyes to the "who", "what" and "why" of City government and the avenues to get involved. You will experience the daily structure and operations of city government - the work, the challenges, and the collaboration between staff and community that make Bellevue a great place to live, work and play. Handson activities allow you to experience the day-to-day challenges of running a local government. Each session includes some pre-class homework, a networking dinner, and presentations and activities from different city departments.

Who should apply?

Bellevue Essentials cohorts are demographically representative of Bellevue's diverse community. Bellevue Essentials is designed for people who are:

- Curious about civic engagement and participation in local government
- Interested in gaining skills and knowledge around how city government works and how to effectively be involved
- Interested in networking with city staff and leadership and emerging community leaders
- Committed to the future of Bellevue and to serving their community
- Live or work in Bellevue (residents are given priority)
- · Elected officials and candidates are not eligible to apply

Every year, Bellevue Essentials receives nearly twice as many applicants as we can accommodate. In 2023, we will accept 35 applicants, so it is important to thoroughly complete your application.

Applications are due on Thursday, July 20, 2023 at 5 p.m. Tuition is \$150.00 (payable after acceptance) and a fee waiver based on financial need is available

What is the class schedule?

- Class is held Wednesday evenings, September 20-November 15
- Dinner at 5:30 p.m. and class from 6-8:30 p.m.
- Class is held Saturday mornings, September 23 and October 7, 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.



- Graduation, Wednesday, November 29, 7-8:30 p.m.
- Attendance is required at 9 of 11 classes to graduate
