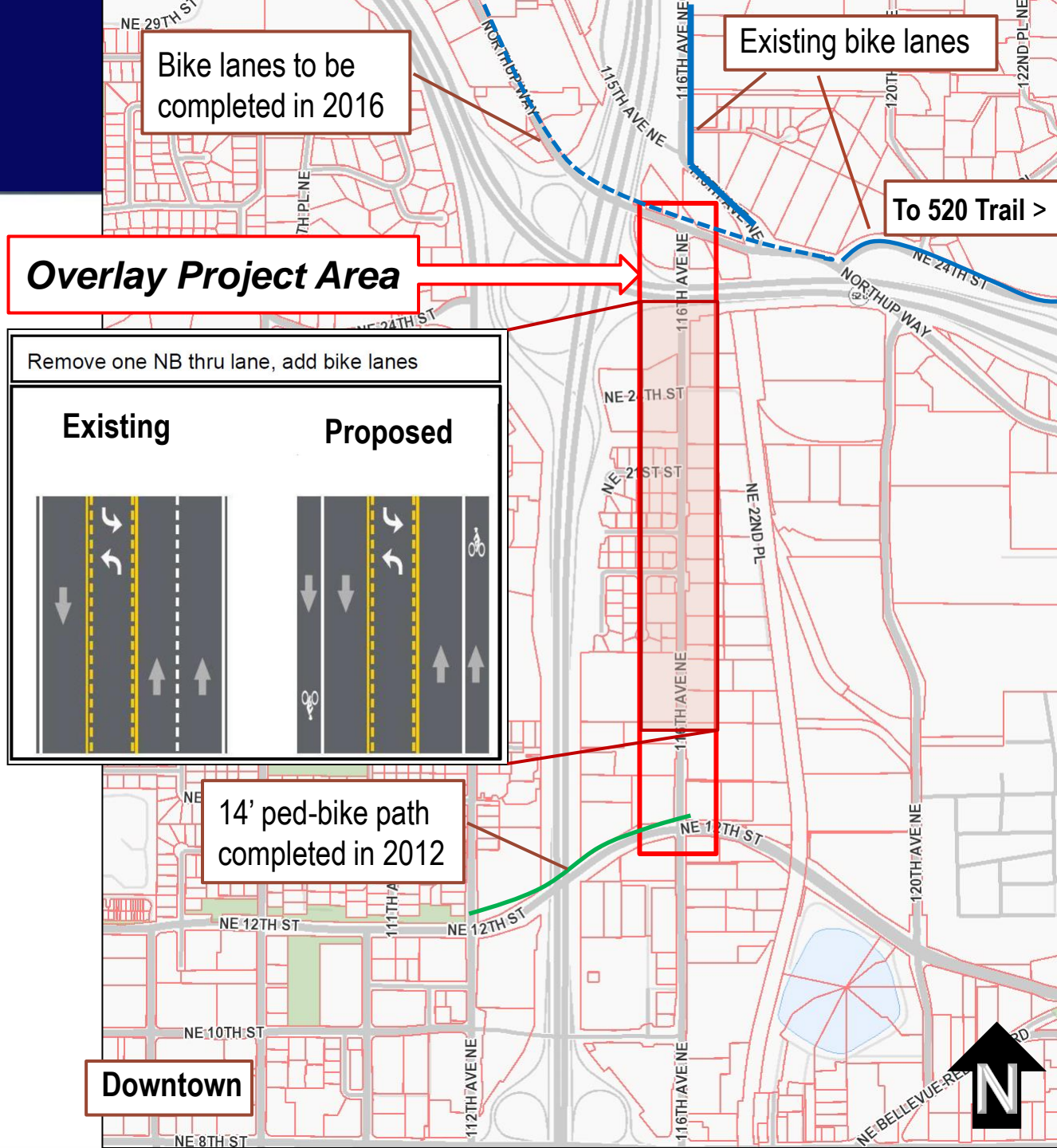

# Proposal

- Modify center segment of corridor to add bike lanes.
- Some community interest in extending bike lane to NE 12<sup>th</sup> St intersection.
  - This option not recommended by staff.



# Anticipated Benefits

- Improved bike linkage between the regional 520 Trail and Downtown Bellevue
- Safety:
  - Dedicated space for bicyclists, marked bike lanes
  - Reduces crossing conflict for pedestrians and eliminates the “multi-lane threat”
  - Creates a buffer space, separating pedestrians from moving vehicles
  - Reduces severity and occurrence of collisions for all modes
  - Improves speed limit compliance.

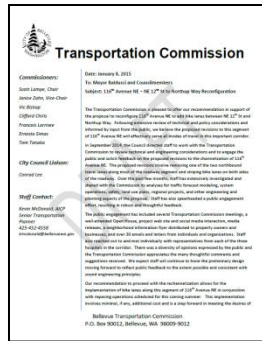
# Monitoring

- Collision data

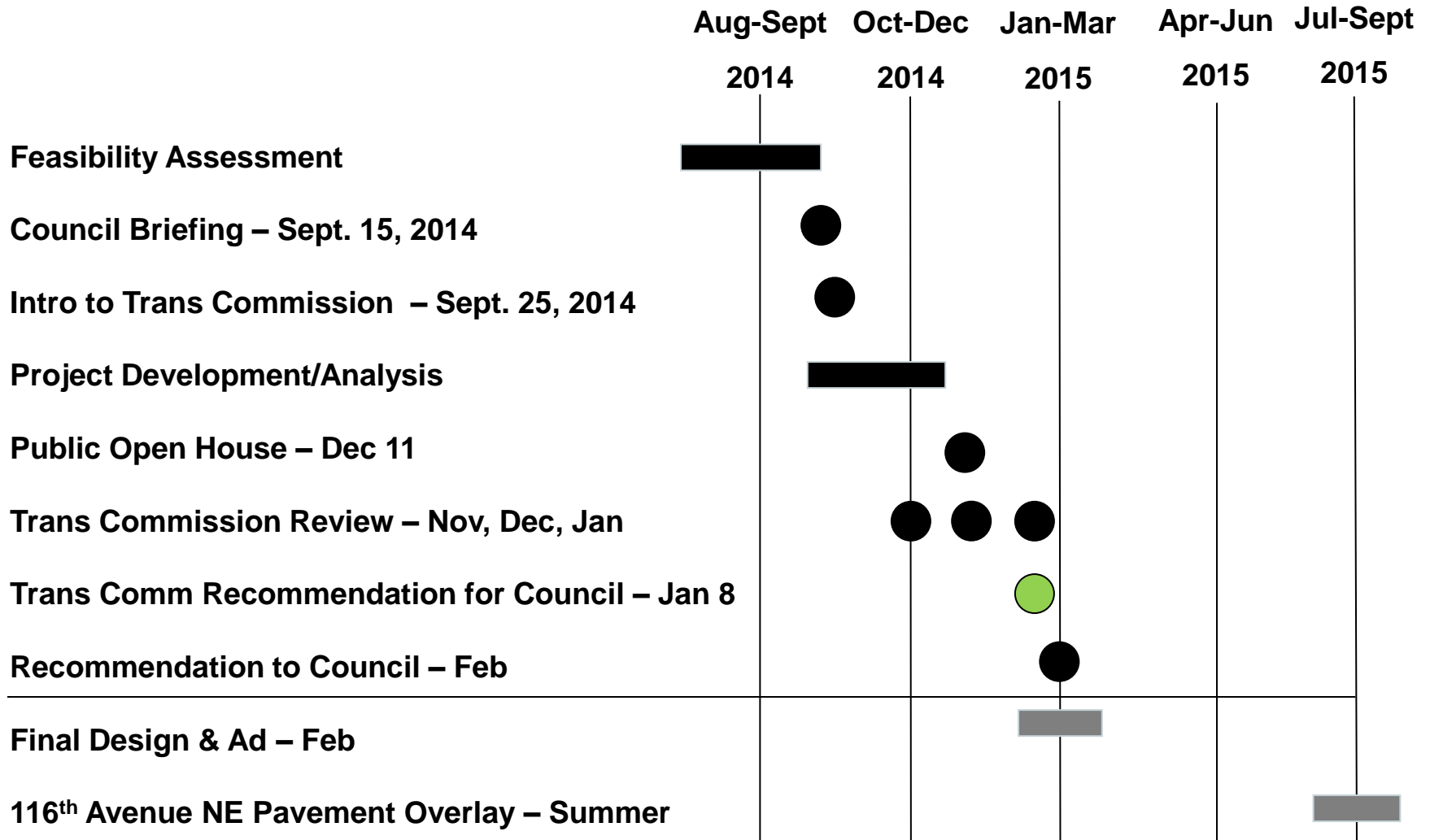
# Recommendation
