# Staff Recommendation—Key Points

- 1. Minimum threshold size of buildings—Revise upwards
- Implementation activities—Provide a menu of options, distinguish higher impact, lower-impact activities
- 3. Office uses—Make base requirements consistent citywide
- Performance goal for office uses—Set at level currently achieved at CTR worksites, expect buildings to achieve over time.
- Good faith effort required all sites; buildings with a performance goal expected to make progress toward goal, no penalty for failing to meet goal.

## **TMP Implementation Activities**

## Commission/Council direction:

Add flexibility to implementation measures, while maintaining minimum requirements

## Recommended approach:

- Required Baseline activities
- Additional "menu" of activities
  - Higher impact activities (0 or 1 needed for a building)
  - Lower impact activities (1 or 2 needed for a building)
- Expected level of implementation activity set at same level as current code (with added flexibility)

- Extend to Office uses city wide.


### Staff Recommendation:

#### Outside DT zone

CTR results: 72% drive-alone



## **Proposed Revision**

• 14.60.070 (A). The director may require a transportation management program (TMP) for any project proposed as mitigation for impacts in order to reduce congestion, reduce peak hour trips, or implement the policies of the comprehensive plan.
