

100TH AVE NE & VICINITY COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT UPDATE



Over the past year, City of Bellevue staff have worked with area residents to develop a complete streets plan to improve connections residents use to reach schools, churches, parks and other destinations in the community.

Project Goals: increase traffic safety and make it more comfortable for people of all ages to walk, bike and drive on 100th Ave NE and priority side streets between Bellevue Way and 98th Ave NE. For more information about the project area, please visit the project website.

Phase I Elements: elements below are currently being designed and will be constructed in 2019. In addition, some Phase II elements are expected to be constructed in 2020/2021 as resources allow.

Pedestrian Safety Improvements for NE 23rd St and NE 24th St/100th Ave NE Intersection

Funded by the Neighborhood Safety, Connectivity & Congestion Levy

NE 23rd St Walkway: An asphalt path separated from traffic by a landscaped planter is planned for the north side of NE 23rd St, between 98th Ave NE and 100th Ave NE. Construction is anticipated to be completed fall 2019. Once installed, parking will only be allowed on the south side of the street.

NE 24th St Crosswalk Improvements: rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB) will be installed at the crosswalk across NE 24th St at 100th Ave NE. RRFBs improve the visibility of people crossing the street and encourage motorists to stop for pedestrians in the crosswalk. In addition, the crosswalk curb ramps will be rebuilt to improve accessibility.

Upcoming Improvements:

Near Clyde Hill Elementary School (front page)

100th Ave NE at NE 10th & NE 12th St (below)

Funded by the Downtown Transportation Plan

100th Ave NE at NE 12th St Crosswalk and Trail Connection Improvements:

- Rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB) at a new crosswalk across 100th Ave NE at NE 12th St
- Crosswalk improvements across NE 12th St on the east side of 100th Ave NE
- Trail connection enhancements along NE 12th St between 100th Ave NE and 102nd Ave NE

Example Roundabout Concept

100th Ave NE at NE 10th St Roundabout:

A roundabout will be installed to reduce congestion, improve operations and increase pedestrian safety at this intersection. Crosswalks will be upgraded with pedestrian “refuge” islands.
