



## **GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING USE OF OPTIONAL DNS PROCESS**

When the **SEPA** field indicates a **Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS)** is expected, the optional DNS process is being used and a DNS is likely. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The proposal may include mitigation measures under applicable codes, and the project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is prepared. The Threshold Determination will also be noticed in a subsequent issue of this Weekly Permit Bulletin. A copy of the subsequent Threshold Determination for the proposal may be obtained upon request.

**Description:** The **East Bellevue Community Council** (EBCC) will hold a final public hearing during its Regular Meeting on **Tuesday, December 5, 2017 at 6:30 p.m.**, in the Lake Hills Clubhouse, 15230 Lake Hills Boulevard, to consider and take final action on Ordinance No. 6376 amending the Bellevue Land Use Code (LUC) to prohibit Community Health Engagement Locations (CHELs), safe injection sites, and other uses or activities designed to provide a location for individuals to consume illicit drugs. The new section 20.10.410 in the LUC defines the activity that occurs at CHELs, safe injection sites, and other supervised consumption facilities, and prohibits this activity outright citywide.
