Traffic signal revision coming to 124th Avenue NE and NE 8th Street intersection

The Bellevue Transportation Department will modify the traffic signal for northbound and southbound travel on 124th Avenue NE at the intersection of NE 8th Street. The project will add northbound and southbound left turn signal displays with flashing yellow arrows.

The signal revision work is expected to be complete mid-August. The intersection will remain open but expect intermittent short-term lane closures.


New signal heads may be installed and covered prior to the new signals being turned on.

Please obey the existing signs and signals until the project is complete. Also, please use caution and drive, ride and walk safely. Obey police officers and flaggers directing traffic through the work zone.

Funding comes from the Signal and Street Lighting minor capital fund and the estimated cost is \$8,000.


Flashing Yellow Arrow Display (What you'll see on the traffic signal)
