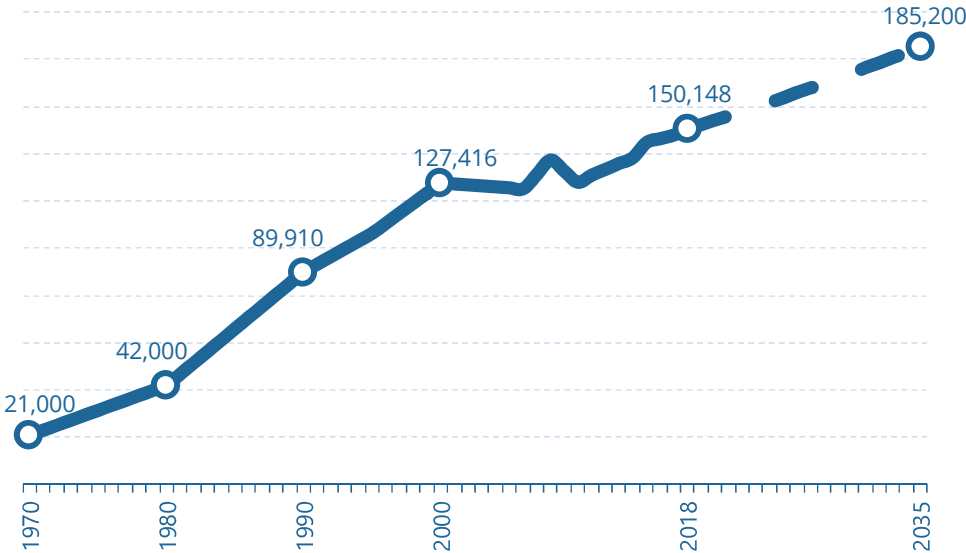

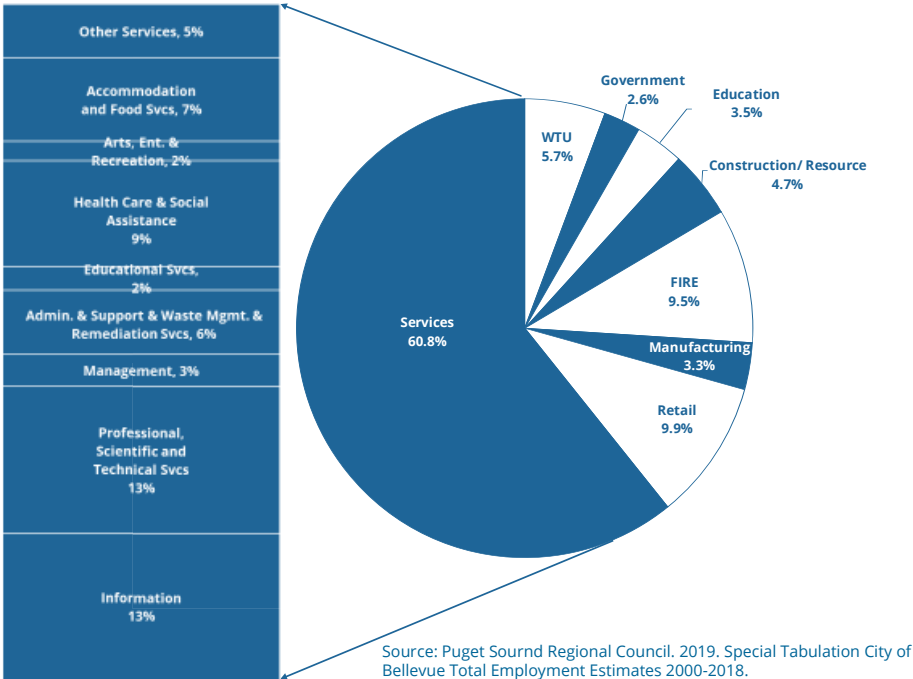

Historic and Projected Job Growth



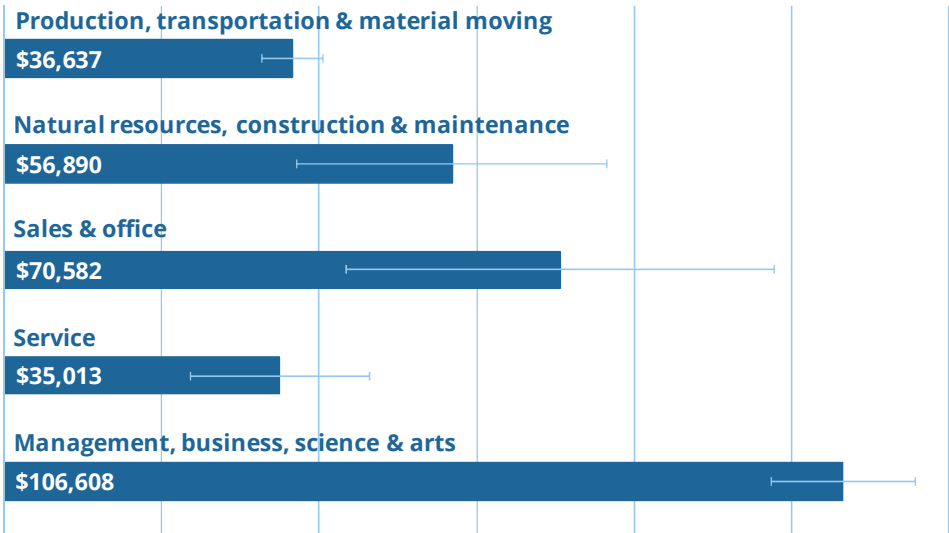

Bellevue Jobs by Industry



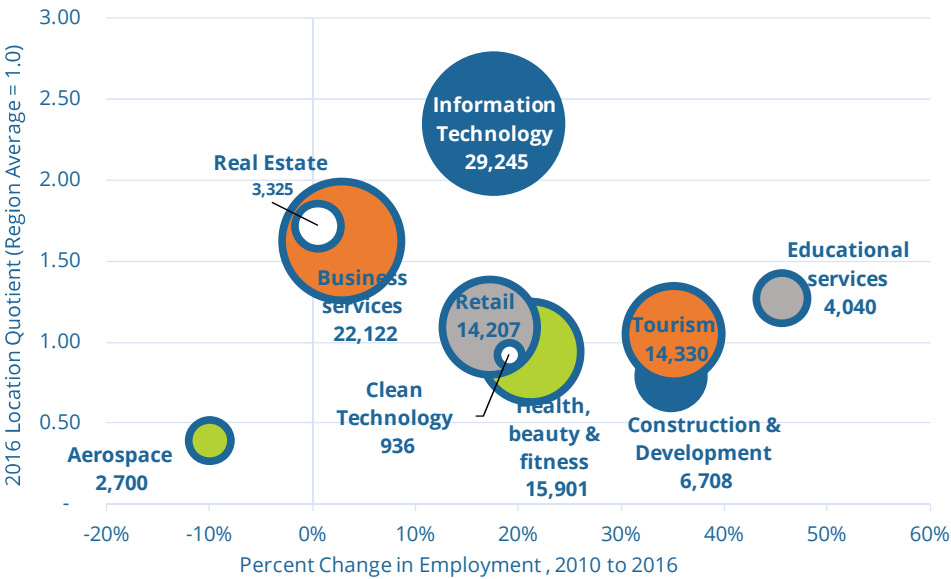

Median Earnings by Occupation



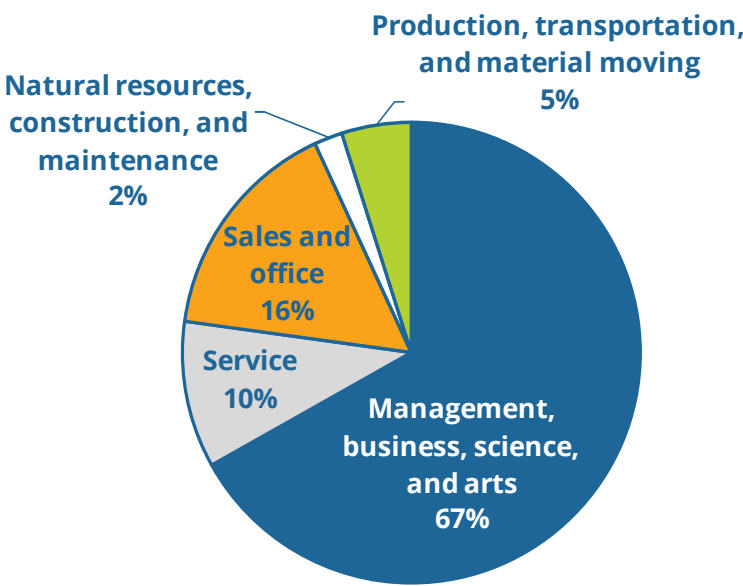

Occupations of Bellevue Residents



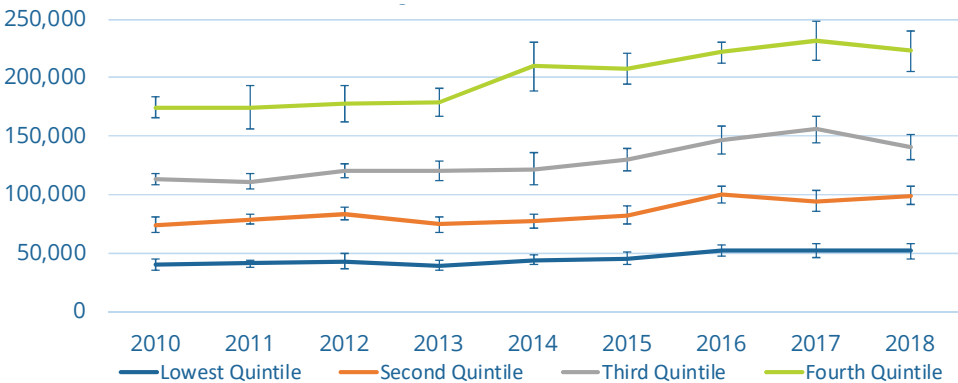
