New bike signals at SE Eastgate Way and 150th Ave SE

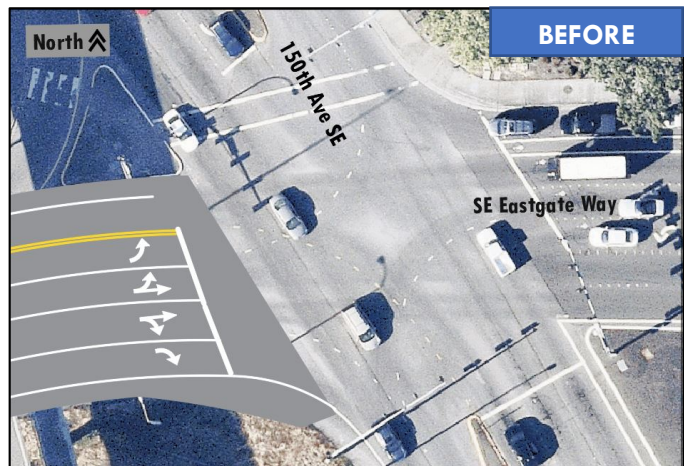
As part of the SE Eastgate Way Bike Safety Improvements, work on traffic revisions at the intersection of SE Eastgate Way and 150th Ave SE will start Aug. 28. See reverse side for a diagram of the new traffic signal configuration.

Drivers use caution:

Travel lanes and signal timing will change for those traveling both directions along SE Eastgate Way. Drive slowly and obey new signs, signals and lane markings. Watch for cyclists.

Bicyclists ride responsibly:

Bike lanes and signals have been installed to provide safe crossings through this busy intersection. Use pushbuttons where provided to activate a green light.



New eastbound bike signal - A bike signal is being added for eastbound bicyclists. When a cyclist traveling eastbound activates the bike signal using a pushbutton, an illuminated “No Turn on Red” sign be displayed, temporarily prohibiting vehicles from turning right onto 150th Avenue SE.

New north-south bike signals - Bike signals are also being added so northbound and southbound bicyclists will be able to cross SE Eastgate Way.

The traffic revision is anticipated to be installed on Aug. 28 as part of the ongoing construction night work on Eastgate Way. Please obey flaggers and police officers as you travel through the work zone.
