CITY OF BELLEVUE
PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD
2020-2024 CDBG CONSOLIDATED PLAN
ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO HOUSING**

The City of Bellevue, Washington, will hold a public hearing before the Human Services Commission on November 5, 2019, to receive comments on the Consolidated Plan for Housing & Community Development and the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing.

In accordance with 24 CFR 91.105, notice is hereby given that the City of Bellevue is developing its draft 2020-2024 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Consolidated Plan for Housing & Community Development. The Consolidated Plan is a report which informs the community, stakeholders and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) how the City of Bellevue (hereinafter referred to as "the City") will invest its CDBG funds from 2020-2024. The Plan also identifies the objectives and strategies that will guide the City's investments. Objectives and strategies are influenced by the City's overarching goal to build a healthy community.

The 2020 Annual Action Plan, which is included in the Consolidated Plan, outlines the City's proposed use of 2020 CDBG funds awarded to the City by HUD under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, known as the Community Development Block Grant Program.

The City is also soliciting public comment on the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing (AI). For purposes of the AI, the duty to affirmatively further fair housing means taking meaningful actions, in addition to combating discrimination, that overcome patterns of segregation and foster inclusive communities free from barriers that restrict access to opportunity based on protected characteristics.

In addition to the public hearing, all interested persons are invited to submit comments on the City's draft 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan and the AI between October 4, 2019 and November 5, 2019.
