APPLIANCES (MAJOR)



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (large appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, stoves, dishwashers, clothes washing machines or dryers, and water heaters - place next to carts as separate item) - **fees apply**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station (accepts 3 appliances per load) - **refrigerant type: \$30 each**
- PSE - pse.com/rebates/recycling/fridge-and-freezer-recycling-rebates

APPLIANCES (SMALL: e.g. MICROWAVE OVENS, TOASTER OVENS, IRONS, COFFEE MAKERS)



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. or smaller and fewer than 60 lbs. Set on top or next to your recycling cart on your service day.) - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. or smaller and fewer than 60 lbs.) - **no fee**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station (mostly metal appliances) - **no fee**

BATTERIES (ALKALINE, BUTTON, & RECHARGABLE)



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate, clear, sealed bags next to your recycling cart) - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate, clear, sealed bags) - **no fee**
- Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site - **no fee**

BIKES & BIKE PARTS



- Donate bikes in good condition to charity - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center - **no fee**

BOOKS (HARDCOVER)



- Donate books in good condition to charity - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center - **no fee**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station - **no fee**

CLOTHING & TEXTILES



- Donate items in good condition to charity - **no fee**
- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in clear plastic bags next to your recycling cart) - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in clear plastic bags) - **no fee**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station (clean, dry clothing and household textiles) - **no fee**



Find local organizations that want all your clothes, shoes, and linens for reuse or recycling - even damaged items - in any condition except wet, mildewed or contaminated with hazardous materials.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup - **fees apply**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station (not accepted from dump trucks, dump trailers, flat beds that dump, or roll-off boxes and items restricted to 8 ft. long and up to 200 lbs.) - **fees apply**

COOKING OIL



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (seal used oil without large solids in clean, clear screw-top plastic jugs with your name and address on it and place next to your recycling cart. Limit 3 gallons per pickup and 10 gallons per year) - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (seal used oil without large solids in clean, clear screw-top plastic jugs with your name and address on it. Limit 3 gallons per drop-off and 10 gallons per year) - **no fee**

ELECTRONICS



Recycle broken, obsolete, or worn-out electronics (TVs, computers, computer monitors, tablets, e-readers, and portable DVD players at no charge at participating locations) - **no fee**

- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. or smaller and fewer than 60 lbs. and place next to your recycling cart) - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (2 ft. x 2 ft. x 2 ft. or smaller and fewer than 60 lbs.) - **no fee**

FLUORESCENT TUBES & BULBS, CFL, & HID LIGHTS

Prohibited from disposing in the garbage



Recycle fluorescent lights, CFLs, and HIDs at no charge at participating locations.

- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (Limit 2 tubes/bulbs each pick-up and 10 bulbs/tubes per year) - **no fee**
 - Tubes: Wrap in paper and secure with tape. No longer than 4 ft.
 - Bulbs: Seal in plastic bag.
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (Limit 2 tubes/bulbs each pick-up and 10 bulbs/tubes per year) - **no fee**
 - Tubes: Wrap in paper and secure with tape. No longer than 4 ft.
 - Bulbs: Seal in plastic bag.
- Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site - **no fee** (limit 10 bulbs/tubes per person per day. If tubes are longer than 8ft., call 206-296-4466 for pre-approval)

FURNITURE



- Donate furniture in good condition to charity - **no fee**
- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup for disposal (place next to carts as separate item) - **fees apply**

LATEX PAINT



Recycle used/unwanted latex paint at participating locations - **fees apply**

- Habitat for Humanity 13500 Bel-Red Road

Latex Paint is NOT HAZARDOUS. Recycle latex paint at participating Green Sheen locations (greensheepaint.com) or dry out and dispose in the garbage by:

- Mixing in equal parts kitty litter until the paint is the consistency of oatmeal.
- Letting the paint sit at least an hour to dry before throwing out.

MATTRESSES OR BOX SPRINGS



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (place next to carts as separate item) - **fees apply**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station - **fees apply**

MEDICINES (UNWANTED, UNUSED OR EXPIRED)



Return medicine securely at a drop-box at participating locations:

MOTOR OIL & FILTERS, ANTIFREEZE, BRAKE FLUID, & GASOLINE (UP TO 30 GALLONS)

- Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site - **no fee**

The shops below accept **used, uncontaminated motor oil**. Drain oil into reusable container, take to a location below, pour into collection tank. **Fees may apply.**

PLASTICS



- Donate items in good condition to charity - **no fee**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (rigid plastics e.g. buckets, PVC pipes, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, toys, and coolers) - **no fee**

PROPANE TANKS & CYLINDERS



- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (small empty cylinders only - no tanks) - **no fee**
- Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site - **no fee**
- Choose refillable propane containers - visit refuelyourfun.org for more information

SCRAP METAL



- Call Republic Services to schedule a pickup (large items only) - **fees may apply**
- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (all ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metal, including lids 3 in. or larger that are free of wood, plastic, rubber, and other contaminants. Smaller pieces okay in your cart) - **no fee**
- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station (items are accepted for recycling if they are 50% or more metal and up to 8 ft. long and up to 200 lbs.) - **no fee**

SHREDDED PAPER



- Shredding with a service, instead of at home, allows the paper to be recycled. The best environmental choice is to shred only what you need, because shredded paper has fewer recycling uses than whole sheets of paper.
- Bring confidential paper documents to a community shred event - visit atg.wa.gov/community-shred-events for more information

STYROFOAM BLOCKS



- Republic Services Recycling Drop-Off Center (no packing peanuts) - **no fee**
- Take clean, dry packing peanuts to Pak Mail for re-use (2620 Bellevue Way NE)

TIRES



- Call your tire shop or dealership to ask about tire recycling options and fees.

WOOD (UNPAINTED, UNTREATED, UNSTAINED)



- Factoria Recycling & Transfer Station (unpainted, untreated, unstained lumber, plywood, pallets, and crates and no wood more than 8 ft. long) - **\$12.00 minimum up to 320 pounds, \$75 per ton fee**

FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY, PLEASE REMEMBER THESE TIPS:

- Don't mix products
- Keep products in original containers when possible
- Label products not in original containers
- Secure products so they won't tip over or leak
- Transport similar, sealed containers upright, in cardboard boxes
- Secure the entire load in your vehicle or trailer. Vehicles arriving with unsecured loads at public or private transfer stations in King County can be charged an unsecured load fee.
- Store products away from the passenger compartment of your vehicle and keep them separate from items you wish to retain.

OIL-BASED PAINT + SOLVENTS



AUTOMOTIVE PRODUCTS, FUEL



Is it hazardous?
If the label says DANGER, POISON, WARNING or CAUTION, it is hazardous. See all accepted materials for drop-off at hazwastehelp.org.

Recycle Used Motor Oil
Place in transparent 1-gallon jugs with screw-on lids. Take to one of the motor oil recycling locations listed on the other side of this mailer. Do not mix automotive fluids together. Businesses that accept used motor oil do not accept oil that's been contaminated with anti-freeze or any other fluid.

Use Less Toxic Options

READ THE LABEL BEFORE YOU BUY. Use the least hazardous product that does the job. Avoid products labeled **DANGER, POISON, CAUTION, or WARNING.**

NEVER MIX HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS.

Do not mix bleach with other cleaners or soaps, especially ammonia products. These mixtures create hazardous gases. **USE SAFER ALTERNATIVES.** Clean efficiently using common, less-hazardous, and inexpensive products. CHOOSE A PRODUCT WITH LITTLE OR NO SCENT AND AVOID AEROSOLS.

Perfume chemicals may be irritants for children and people with respiratory ailments or sensitive skin. Aerosol overspray may contain propellants or solvents. Pump sprayers or wipe-on liquids typically use less product.

AVOID AIR FRESHENERS AND FABRIC SOFTENERS. These products add particles and perfume chemicals to indoor and outdoor air, which may trigger asthma and skin ailments.

TRUE OR FALSE?

Indoor air is cleaner than the air outdoors. **FALSE.** We spend almost all of our time indoors where air is almost 100 times more polluted from gases and particles than outside. Open windows occasionally to air out your home with a fresh breeze. (Source: U.S. Environmental Protection Agency)
