

### Bellevue Bike Share Welcome

The City of Bellevue launched a one-year bike share pilot in July 2018. Green, electric-assisted bicycles are available citywide to use on streets, bike lanes, and sidewalks. The bikes are owned and operated by Lime, a private company that paid a fee for a permit to provide bike share service in Bellevue subject to specific conditions.





If you have noticed bike share bicycles parked on your property, designating one of these near a building entrance or in a parking lot or plaza might be helpful for your visitors, tenants, or workers who arrive by bike share and could reduce the number of bikes you see left in places you do not want them.


