PARKING LOT EVENTS

Drive-in cultural events (i.e. concerts, performances) will likely require a Noise Permit depending on the location and the timing of the event. Noise Permits may be issued for events between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Saturday, no permits may be issued for Sound Amplification on Sundays.

• Submittal Requirements: <u>amplified sound</u> <u>application</u>, site sketch/site plan

• Permit Fee: \$184

• Typical Approval Timeline: 1 week
