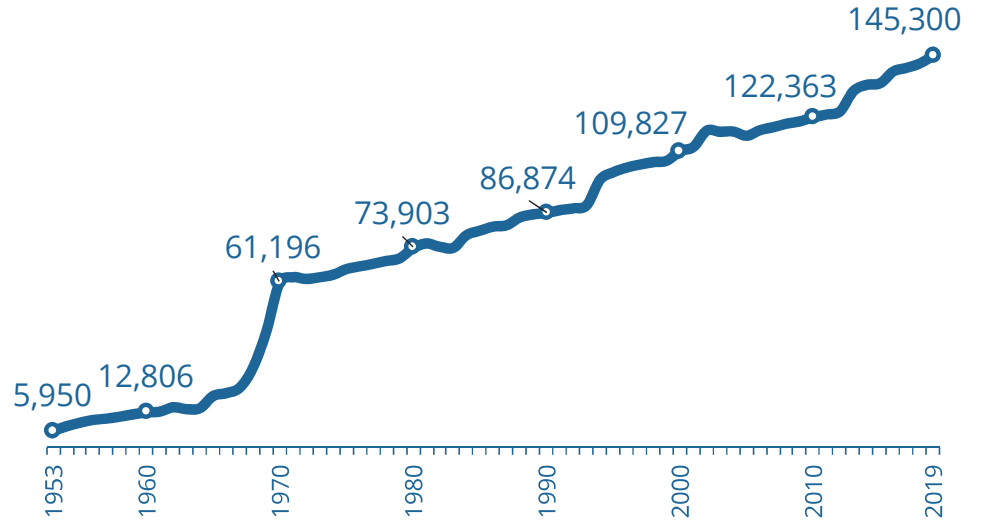

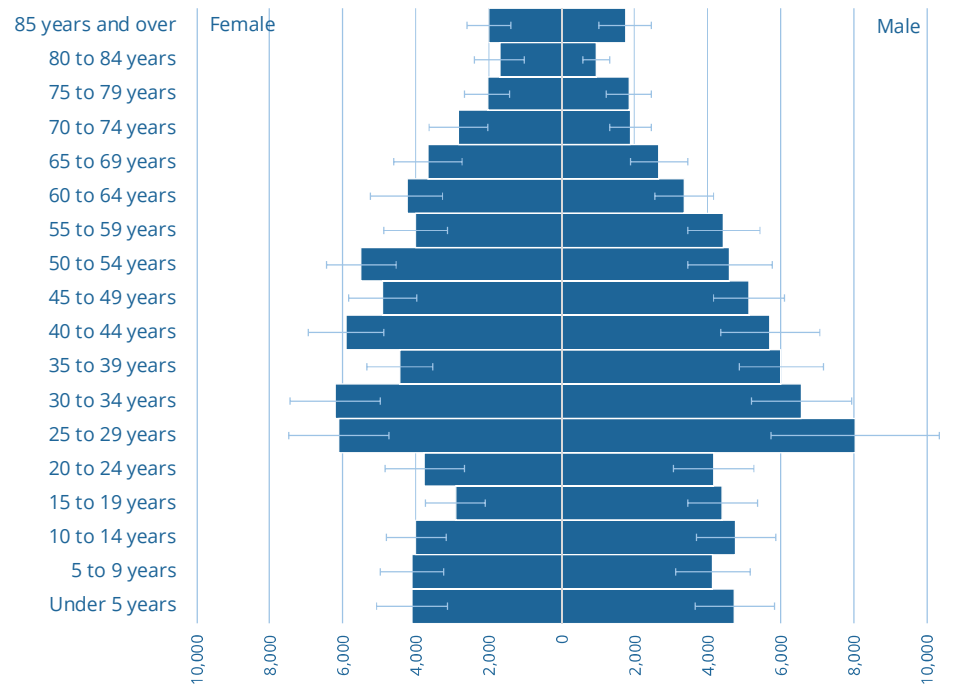

Population 1953 to 2019



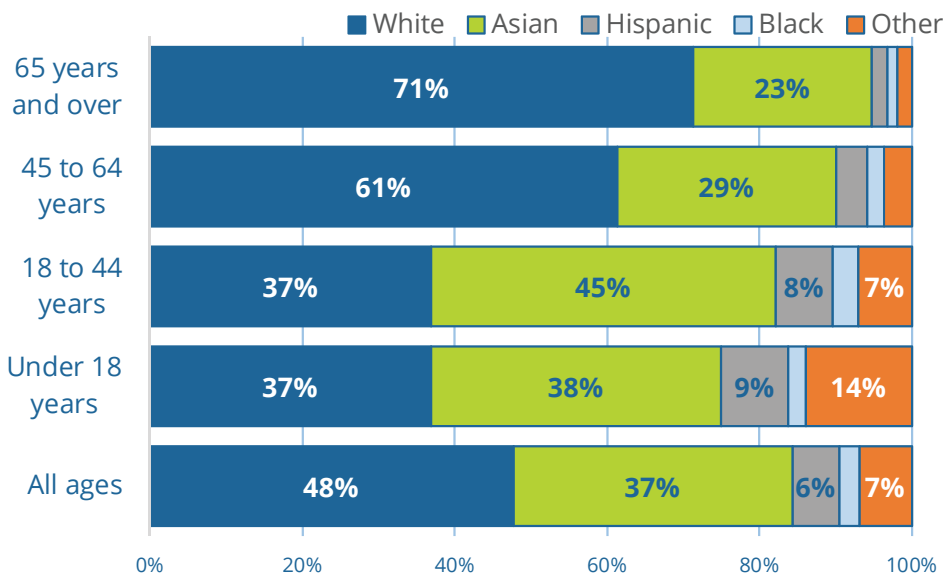

Population by Age



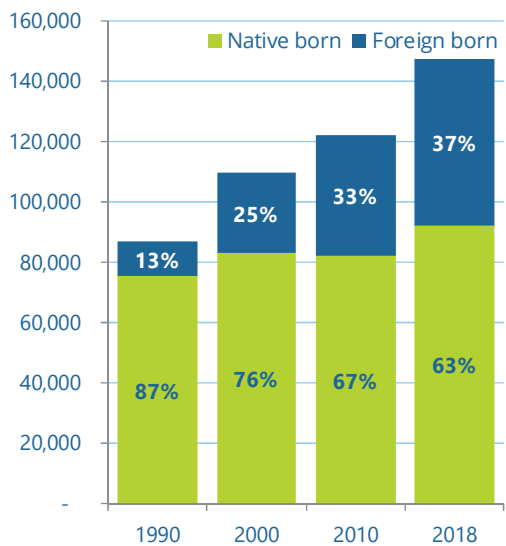

Race by Age



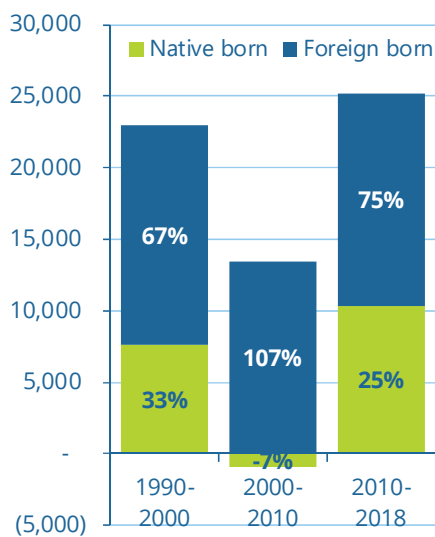

Population by Place of Birth



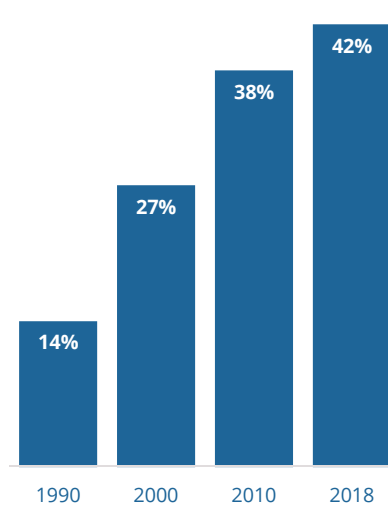

Pop. Change by Place of Birth

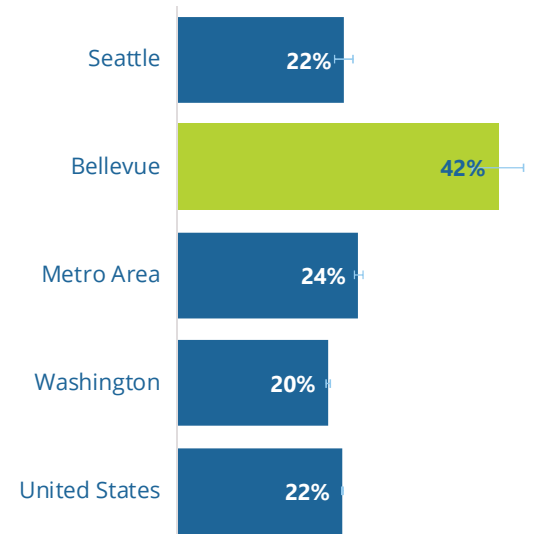

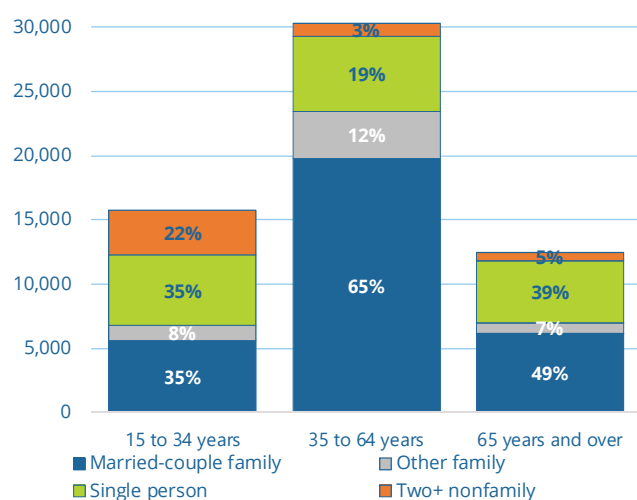
