Main Street Sidewalk Safety Repair Project

Dear Main Street Neighbor,

With the summer season coming to a close, the Bellevue Transportation Department will begin work on its Main Street Sidewalk Safety Repair Project. This work will repair and replace sidewalk pavers in 40 different locations on the north side of Main Street, between 103rd Avenue NE and 100th Avenue NE.

This repair is part of the city's street maintenance program and was originally scheduled earlier in the summer but was deferred to accommodate the implementation of the temporary on-street dining program. To the extent possible, the work will not affect permitted sidewalk café areas.



We will work with businesses where paver repair is near to ensure access is maintained and construction impacts are minimized.

What to expect:

- Construction is anticipated to begin Tuesday, Sept. 15 and be complete within 3 weeks, if not sooner.
- The work is weather dependent and the construction schedule is subject to change.
- Approved work hours are Monday Friday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Business, residential, pedestrian and food take-out access will be maintained during construction.
- Repair areas will be pre-marked.
- Flowerpots may need to be temporarily relocated to conduct repair.
- Plywood will be temporarily placed over areas under repair.
- Contractor parking will require up to two spaces.
- A generator will be used to power the needed hand tools; expect some noise.
- The city's contractor has a COVID-19 Standard Operating Plan.



Funding

Funding for this project comes from the city's Street Maintenance Program and estimated cost is \$28,000.


