Recycle Used Motor Oil

Do you change your own oil?

Find recycling locations in Bellevue for your used motor oil and used filters at bellevuewa.gov/recycle-motor-oil or call the recycling hotline at 425-452-6932. Participating Bellevue stores collect small quantities of oil amounting to over 15,000 gallons of oil and over 10,000 filters each year for recycling from do-it-yourself oil changes!

Do you take your car to the shop for oil changes?

Make sure the shop recycles used motor oil and used oil filters. Not all shops recycle both. Visit the website listed above for locations that recycle both motor oil and filters.

Hazardous materials

- ◆ Car batteries
- ◆ Brake fluid
- ◆ Gasoline
- ◆ Flares
- ◆ Carburetor cleaner
- ◆ Engine degreaser
- ◆ Antifreeze
- ◆ Transmission fluid

Take them to the Factoria Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 13800 SE 32nd Street. No appointment required. Drop off items FREE 8:00a.m.-4:00p.m. Tue-Fri and 9:00a.m.-5:00p.m. Sat-Sun! See www.kingcountyhazwastewa.gov for more information.

Why recycle motor oil and filters?

- ◆ Oil is a valuable energy resource and two gallons of used motor oil can generate enough electricity for an average home for one day.
- ◆ One gallon of oil can contaminate one million gallons of fresh water (about a year's supply of water for 50 people).
- ◆ Oil filters are made of steel, which is highly recyclable.
- ◆ Recycling all oil filters sold in the US each year would produce 160,000 tons of steel (enough for 15 Mariner's Stadium roofs).
