TERMINATION OF PROCLAMATION OF CIVIL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Police Department had reason to believe there was an imminent threat that the demonstration advertised to occur the evening of October 24, 2020, threatened to result in destruction of or damage to property and injury to persons; and


WHEREAS, in my capacity as Mayor of the City of Bellevue, I proclaimed a civil emergency existed in the City of Bellevue in a Proclamation of Civil Emergency dated October 24, 2020, pursuant to Bellevue City Code, Chapter 9.22; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Police Department has reason now to believe that the threat of destruction of damage to persons or property within the City has subsided; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the undersigned, the extraordinary measures that were required to protect the public peace, safety and welfare within the City are no longer needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Bellevue, Washington does proclaim the civil emergency declared on October 24, 2020 no longer exists and hereby orders the Proclamation of Civil Emergency dated October 24, 2020 terminated as of the date and time of this Order of Termination. This Order of Termination also terminates the Civil Emergency Order Establishing Prohibiting Items issued on October 24, 2020.
