


Here are just some of the basic milestones covered in our Parkside Pre-Kindergarten in order to prepare your little one for Kindergarten in the Bellevue School District.

Kindergarten Math:

- · Count from 1-100 by ones and by tens
- · Beginning addition and subtraction within 10
- Write numbers up to 20
- Compare groups with more, less and equal amounts
- · Categorize objects by similar attributes
- Name basic geometric shapes

Kindergarten English:

- Name and print upper and lower-case letters
- Write your full name
- Spell simple words phonetically
- Sort words and similar objects into categories
- · Build and expand common vocabulary
- Understand basic synonyms and plural nouns
