



Pikes Peak Reservoir Replacement Project

Construction starting June 2021

Bellevue Utilities will be removing the existing reservoir and pump station building at Bridle Trails State Park and constructing a new reservoir in the same location. The new pump station operation has been incorporated into the recently reconstructed Cherry Crest Pump Station facility located next to the Cherry Crest Mini Park. These are high-priority projects because these valuable water system assets provide water service reliability and fire protection to the residents of the Bridle Trails, Pikes Peak and Cherry Crest neighborhoods.

What to expect:


- Work is anticipated to last from June 2021 to Fall 2022.
- Work will occur Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Longer weekday hours may be necessary at times, TBD.
- Construction work will occur in NE 39th St and in the park.
- Park access and trails in the vicinity of the project site will be maintained during construction for park users.
- Flaggers and signage will be present to highlight any detours.

Equipment and noise:

- Expect to hear construction machinery and trucks during work hours.
- At times, work may include use of vibratory and high impact equipment that may cause noise and vibrations.
- Construction equipment and vehicles will access the site via an existing access road off of NE 39th St.
- Equipment and materials will be staged and stored in designated fenced areas within the work site.


Project background

Bellevue Utilities formed and collaborated with a Community Advisory Group (CAG) consisting of community leaders and neighbors to evaluate alternatives and identify the best option to replace the reservoir and pump station. The project team and the Pikes Peak CAG assessed several alternatives based on various criteria and independently arrived at the same preferred alternative: a circular prestressed concrete reservoir with the pump station being moved offsite to the existing Cherry Crest reservoir and pump station facility located next to Cherry Crest Mini Park.
